

1 Kings 7:51· Finally all the work that King Solomon had to do as regards the house of Yehowah was at its completion, and Solomon began to bring in the things made holy by David his father, the silver and the gold and the articles he put in the treasures of the house of Yehowah.

[15] - References:

- Finally he set up the courtyard round about the tabernacle and the altar and **put** up the screen of the gate of the courtyard. So Moses finished the **work**. (**Exodus 40:33**)
- These also **King David** sanctified to **Yehowah**, together with the **silver** and the **gold** that he had sanctified from all the nations that he had subdued. (**2 Samuel 8:11**)
- Finally all the **work** that **Solomon** had to do for the **house of Yehowah** was at its **completion**, and **Solomon** began to **bring** in the **things made holy** by **David** his **father**, and the **silver** and the **gold** and all the utensils he **put** in the **treasures** of the **house** of the true God. (**2 Chronicles 5:1**)
- But all the **silver** and the **gold** and the **articles** of copper and iron are something **holy** to **Yehowah**. Into the treasure of **Yehowah** it should go. (**Joshua 6:19**)
- And he got to take the **treasures** of the **house** of **Yehowah** and the **treasures** of the **house** of the king, and everything he took. And he went on to take all the **gold** shields that **Solomon** had **made**. (**1 Kings 14:26**)
- And Jehoash proceeded to say to the priests; All the money for the **holy** offerings that is brought to the **house** of **Yehowah**, the money at which each one is assessed, the money for the souls according to individual valuation, all the money that it comes up on the heart of each one to **bring** to the **house** of **Yehowah**. (**2 Kings 12:4**)
- As **regards** the Levites, Ahijah was over the **treasures** of the **house** of the true God and over the **treasures** of the **things made holy**. (**1 Chronicles 26:20**)
- So Solomon's **work** was all in a prepared state from the day of the foundation-laying of the **house** of **Yehowah** until it was

- finished. So the **house** of **Yehowah** was complete. (**2 Chronicles 8:16**)
- For ships belonging to the king were going to Tarshish with the servants of Hiram. Once every three years ships of Tarshish would come in, carrying **gold** and **silver**, ivory, and apes and peacocks. (**2 Chronicles 9:21**)
 - So Shishak the king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem and took the **treasures** of the **house** of **Yehowah** and the **treasures** of the king's **house**. Everything he took, and so he took the **gold** shields that **Solomon** had **made**. (**2 Chronicles 12:9**)
 - And he proceeded to **bring** the **things made holy** by his **father** and the **things made holy** by himself into the **house** of the true God, **silver** and **gold** and utensils. (**2 Chronicles 15:18**)
 - Asa now brought out **silver** and **gold** from the **treasures** of **Yehowah's house** and the king's **house** and sent to Ben-hadad the king of Syria, who was dwelling at Damascus, saying; (**2 Chronicles 16:2**)
 - Then all the congregation concluded a covenant with the king in the **house** of the true God, after which he said to them; Look! The son of the king himself will reign, just a **Yehowah** promised concerning the sons of **David**. (**2 Chronicles 23:3**)
 - And he took all the **gold** and the **silver** and all the **articles** that were to be found in the **house** of the true God with Obed-edom and the **treasures** of the king's **house** and the hostages, and then returned to Samaria. (**2 Chronicles 25:24**)
 - And this is the word that they gave back to us, saying; We are the servants of the God of the heavens and the earth, and we are rebuilding the **house** that had been built many years before this, which a great king of Israel built and finished. (**Ezra 5:11**)
