

1 Kings 8:22· And Solomon began standing before the altar of Yehowah in front of all the congregation of Israel, and he now spread his palms out to the heavens.

- And he **began standing before** the **altar** of **Yehowah** in **front** of all the **congregation** of **Israel**, and he now **spread out** his **palms**. (**2 Chronicles 6:12**)
- So Moses said to him; As soon as I go **out** of the city I shall **spread** my hands up to **Yehowah**. The thunders will stop and the hail will not continue any longer, in order that you may know that the earth belongs to **Yehowah**. (**Exodus 9:29**)
- And at the grain offering of the evening I stood up from my humiliation, with my garment and my sleeveless coat torn apart, and I proceeded to kneel upon my knees and **spread out** my **palms** to **Yehowah** my God. (**Ezra 9:5**)
- Thus I shall bless you during my lifetime, in your name I shall raise my **palms**. (**Psalms 63:4**)
- Whatever prayer, whatever request for favor there may occur on the part of any man or of all your people **Israel**, because they know each one the plague of his own heart, and they actually **spread out** their **palms** to this house. (**1 Kings 8:38**)
- And the runners kept **standing** each one with his weapons in his hand, from the right side of the house clear to the left side of the house, by the **altar** and by the house, all around near the king. (**2 Kings 11:11**)
- Then he made the copper **altar**, twenty cubits being its length, and twenty cubits its width, and ten cubits its height. (**2 Chronicles 4:1**)
- Then Ezra blessed **Yehowah** the true God, the great One, at which all the people answered; Amen! Amen! with the lifting up of their hands. They then bowed low and prostrated themselves to **Yehowah** with their faces to the earth. (**Nehemiah 8:6**)
- The words of the congregator, the son of David the king in Jerusalem. (**Ecclesiastes 1:1**)

- **And when YOU spread out YOUR palms, I hide my eyes from YOU. Even though YOU make many prayers, I am not listening, with bloodshed YOUR very hands have become filled. (Isaiah 1:15)**
