- Then he said; Your name will no longer be called Jacob but **Israel**, for you have contended with **God** and with men so that you at last prevailed. (**Genesis 32:28**)
- Then **God** said once more to Moses; This is what you are to say to the sons of **Israel**; Yehowah the **God** of **YOUR** forefathers, the **God** of Abraham, the **God** of Isaac and the **God** of Jacob, has sent me to **YOU**. This is my name to time indefinite, and this is the memorial of me to generation after generation. (**Exodus 3:15**)
- Consequently David blessed **Yehowah before** the eyes of all the congregation and David said; Blessed may you be, O **Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel** our father, from time indefinite even to time indefinite. (**1 Chronicles 29:10**)
- Who among the gods is like you, O **Yehowah** Who is like you, proving yourself mighty in holiness. The One to be feared with songs of praise, the One doing marvels. (**Exodus 15:11**)
- There is no one holy like **Yehowah**, for there is no one but you, and there is no rock like our **God**. (**1 Samuel 2:2**)
- That is why you are indeed great, O Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, for there is no other like you, and there is no **God** except you among all of whom we have heard with our ears. (**2 Samuel 7:22**)
- There is none like you among the gods, O **Yehowah**, neither are there any works like yours. (**Psalms 86:8**)
- In no way is there anyone like you, O **Yehowah**. You are great, and your name is great in mightiness. (**Jeremiah 10:6**)
- Who is a **God** like you, one pardoning error and passing over transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? He will certainly

- not hold onto his anger forever, for he is delighting in **loving-kindness**. (**Micah 7:18**)
- And you well know that **Yehowah** your **God** is the true **God**, the faithful **God**, **keeping covenant** and **loving-kindness** in the case of those who love him and those who keep his commandments to a thousand generations. (**Deuteronomy 7:9**)
 - And I went on to **say**; Ah, **Yehowah** the **God** of the **heavens**, the **God** great and fear-inspiring, **keeping the covenant** and **loving-kindness toward** those loving him and **keeping his** commandments. (**Nehemiah 1:5**)
 - **O Yehowah God**, do not turn back the face of your anointed one. **O** do remember the loving-kindnesses to David your servant. (**2 Chronicles 6:42**)
 - When Abram got to be ninety-nine years old, then **Yehowah** appeared to Abram and said to him; I am **God** Almighty. Walk **before** me and prove yourself faultless. (**Genesis 17:1**)

 - **O Sovereign Lord Yehowah**, you yourself have started to make your servant see your greatness and your strong arm, for who is a god in the **heavens** or on the **earth** that does deeds like yours and mighty performances like yours? (**Deuteronomy 3:24**)
 - And Hezekiah began to pray **before Yehowah** and **say**; **O Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel**, sitting upon the cherubs, you alone are the true **God** of all the kingdoms of the **earth**. You yourself have made the **heavens** and the **earth**. (**2 Kings 19:15**)
 - And he went on to **say**; **O Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel**, there is no **God** like you in the **heavens** or on the **earth**, **keeping the covenant** and the **loving-kindness toward** your **servants** who are **walking before** you with all their **heart**. (**2 Chronicles 6:14**)
 - And he proceeded to **say**; **O Yehowah** the **God** of our forefathers, are you not **God** in the **heavens**, and are you not dominating over all the kingdoms of the nations, and are there not in your hand power and mightiness, with no one to hold his ground against you? (**2 Chronicles 20:6**)

- **And now, O our God, the God great, mighty and fear-inspiring, keeping the covenant and loving-kindness, do not let all the hardship that has found us, our kings, our princes and our priests and our prophets and our forefathers and all your people from the days of the kings of Assyria down to this day, seem little before you. (Nehemiah 9:32)**
