- But will God truly dwell with mankind upon the earth? Look! Heaven, yes, the heaven of the heavens themselves, cannot contain you, how much less, then, this house that I have built? (2 Chronicles 6:18)
- This is what Yehowah has said; The heavens are my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where, then, is the house that you people can build for me, and where, then, is the place as a resting-place for me? (Isaiah 66:1)
- And it came about that when Yehowah was to take Elijah in a windstorm up to the heavens, Elijah and Elisha proceeded to go from Gilgal. (2 Kings 2:1)
- Behold, to Yehowah your God belong the heavens, even the heavens of the heavens, the earth and all that is in it. (Deuteronomy 10:14)
- And who could retain power to build him a house? For the heavens and the heaven of the heavens cannot contain him, and who am I that I should build him a house except for making sacrificial smoke before him? (2 Chronicles 2:6)
- You are Yehowah alone, you yourself have made the heavens, even the heaven of the heavens, and all their army, the earth and all that is upon it, the seas and all that is in them, and you are preserving all of them alive, and the army of the heavens are bowing down to you. (Nehemiah 9:6)
- I know a man in union with Christ who, fourteen years ago, whether in the body I do not know, or out of the body I do not know, God knows, was caught away as such to the third heaven. (2 Corinthians 12:2)
- Yehowah has become high above all the nations, his glory is above the heavens. (Psalms 113:4)

- **Let them praise the name of Yehowah, for his name alone is unreachably high. His dignity is above **earth** and **heaven**. (Psalms 148:13)**
- **Or can any man be concealed in places of concealment and I myself not see him? Is the utterance of Yehowah. Is it not the **heavens** and the **earth** that I myself actually fill? Is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:24)**
- **The **heaven** is my throne, and the **earth** is my footstool. What sort of **house** will **you** build for me? Yehowah says. Or what is the place for my resting? (Acts of Apostles 7:49)**
- **The **God** that made the world and all the things in it, being, as this One is, Lord of **heaven** and **earth**, does not **dwell** in handmade temples. (Acts of Apostles 17:24)**
- **You will bring them and plant them in the mountain of your inheritance; An established place that you **have** made ready for you to inhabit, O Yehowah, a sanctuary, O Yehowah, that your hands **have** established. (Exodus 15:17)**
- **This is what Cyrus the king of Persia has said; All the kingdoms of the **earth** Yehowah the **God** of the **heavens** has given me, and he himself has commissioned me to build him a **house** in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. (Ezra 1:2)**
- **O Yehowah our Lord, how majestic your name is in all the **earth**, you whose dignity is recounted above the **heavens**! (Psalms 8:1)**
- **This is my resting-place forever, here I shall **dwell**, for I **have** longed for it. (Psalms 132:14)**
- **For this is what the High and Lofty One, who is residing forever and whose name is holy, has said; In the height and in the holy place is where I reside, also with the one crushed and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly ones and to revive the heart of the ones being crushed. (Isaiah 57:15)**
