- From the **established place** where he dwells he has gazed at all those **dwelling** on the earth. (**Psalms 33:14**)
- Look from heaven and see out of your lofty abode of holiness and beauty. Where are your zeal and your full might, the commotion of your inward parts, and your mercies? Toward me they have restrained themselves. (**Isaiah 63:15**)
- For there is the true forgiveness with you, in order that you may be feared. (**Psalms 130:4**)
- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his **ways** are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice, Righteous and upright is he. (**Deuteronomy 32:4**)
- For according to the way earthling man **acts** he will reward him, and according to the path of man he will cause it to come upon him. (**Job 34:11**)
- Yehowah rewards me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands he repays me. (**Psalms 18:20**)
- I, Yehowah, am searching the **heart**, examining the kidneys, even to **give** to each one according to his **ways**, according to the fruitage of his dealings. (**Jeremiah 17:10**)

If you search for him, he will let himself be found by you, but if you leave him, he will cast you off forever. (**1 Chronicles 28:9**)

(**2 Chronicles 6:30**)

 - And they prayed and said; You, O Yehowah, who **know** the **hearts** of all, designate which one of these two men you have chosen. (**Acts of Apostles 1:24**)
 - Divine One, God, Yehowah, Divine One, God, Yehowah, he is knowing, and Israel, he too will **know**. If it is in rebellion and if it is in unfaithfulness against Yehowah, do not save us this day. (**Joshua 22:22**)
 - But as soon as they were at rest, they would again do what is bad before you, and you would leave them to the hand of their enemies, who would tread them down. Then they would return and call to you for aid, and you yourself would hear from the very **heavens** and deliver them in accord with your abundant mercy, time and again. (**Nehemiah 9:28**)
