- So Moses said to the people; Do not be afraid, because for the sake of putting **you** to the test the true God has come, and in order that the **fear** of him may continue before **YOUR** faces that **you** may not sin. (**Exodus 20:20**)
- In order that you may **fear** Yehowah your God so as to keep all his statutes and his commandments that I am commanding you, you and your son and your grandson, all the **days** of your life, and in order that your **days** may prove long. (**Deuteronomy 6:2**)
- The **fear** of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride and the bad way and the perverse mouth I have hated. (**Proverbs 8:13**)
- Yehowah now appeared to Abram and said; To your seed I am going to give this land. After that he built an altar there to Yehowah, who had appeared to him. (**Genesis 12:7**)
- Moses my servant is dead, and now get up, cross this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the sons of Israel. (**Joshua 1:2**)
- To the end that they may **fear** you by walking in your ways all the **days** that they are **alive** upon the **surface** of the **ground** that you **gave** to our **forefathers**. (**2 Chronicles 6:31**)
