- And on the twenty-third day of the seventh month he sent the people away to their homes, joyful and feeling good at heart over the goodness that Yehowah had performed toward David and toward Solomon and toward Israel his people. (2 Chronicles 7:10)
- And you must rejoice before Yehowah your God, you and your son and your daughter and your man slave and your slave girl and the Levite who is inside your gates and the alien resident and the fatherless boy and the widow, who are in your midst, in the place that Yehowah your God will choose to have his name reside there. (Deuteronomy 16:11)
- O come let us cry out joyfully to Yehowah! Let us shout in triumph to our Rock of salvation. (Psalms 95:1)
- Joyfully cry out, O daughter of Zion! Break out in cheers, O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! (Zephaniah 3:14)
- How abundant your goodness is, which you have treasured up for those fearing you! Which you have rendered to those taking refuge in you, in front of the sons of men. (Psalms 31:19)
- The loving-kindnesses of Yehowah I shall mention, the praises of Yehowah, according to all that Yehowah has rendered to us, even the abundant goodness to the house of Israel that he has rendered to them according to his mercies and according to the abundance of his loving-kindnesses. (Isaiah 63:7)
- And they will certainly come and cry out joyfully on the height of Zion and become radiant over the goodness of Yehowah, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young ones of the flock and the cattle. And their soul will simply become like a well-watered garden, and no more will they languish again. (Jeremiah 31:12)

- **After that Jacob blessed Pharaoh and went out from before Pharaoh. (Genesis 47:10)**
- **And YOU must rejoice before Yehowah YOUR God, YOU and YOUR sons and YOUR daughters and YOUR man slaves and YOUR slave girls and the Levite who is inside YOUR gates, because he has no share or inheritance with YOU. (Deuteronomy 12:12)**
- **And all the people proceeded to go each one to his own house. Accordingly David went around to bless his own house. (1 Chronicles 16:43)**
- **And there came to be great rejoicing in Jerusalem, for from the days of Solomon the son of David the king of Israel there was none like this in Jerusalem. (2 Chronicles 30:26)**
- **This is the day that Yehowah has made, we will be joyful and rejoice in it. (Psalms 118:24)**
- **With the mention of the abundance of your goodness they will bubble over, and because of your righteousness they will cry out joyfully. (Psalms 145:7)**
- **Go, eat your food with rejoicing and drink your wine with a good heart, because already the true God has found pleasure in your works. (Ecclesiastes 9:7)**
