- Hezekiah himself became king at the age of twenty-five years, and for twenty-nine years he reigned in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Abijah the daughter of Zechariah. (**2 Chronicles 29:1**)
- Hezekiah became father to Manasseh, Manasseh became father to Amon, Amon became father to Josiah. (**Matthew 1:10**)
- The things concealed belong to Yehowah our **God**, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons to time indefinite, that we may carry out all the words of this Law. (**Deuteronomy 29:29**)
- O the depth of God's riches and wisdom and knowledge! How unsearchable his judgments are and past tracing out his ways are! (**Romans 11:33**)
- And now if to the king it seems good, let there be an investigation in the king's house of treasures that is there in Babylon, whether it is so that from Cyrus the king an order was put **through** to rebuild that house of **God** in Jerusalem, and the decision of the king concerning this let him send to us. (**Ezra 5:17**)
- It was then that Darius the king put an order **through**, and they made an investigation in the house of the records of the treasures deposited there in Babylon. (**Ezra 6:1**)
- I was a real father to the poor ones, and the legal case of one whom I did not know, I would examine it. (**Job 29:16**)
- Then David said to the young man that was telling him; How do you really know that Saul has died and also Jonathan his son? (**2 Samuel 1:5**)

· So an order has been put **through** by me, and they have investigated and found that that city has from the days of old been one rising up against **kings** and one in which rebellion and revolt have been carried on. (**Ezra 4:19**)

· And besides the fact that the congregator had become wise, he also taught the people knowledge continually, and he pondered and made a thorough search, that he might arrange many proverbs in order. (**Ecclesiastes 12:9**)
