- Please, may the badness of wicked ones come to an end, and may you establish the righteous one, and God as righteous is testing out heart and kidneys. (**Psalms 7:9**)
- You **have** set our errors right in front of you, our hidden **things** before your bright face. (**Psalms 90:8**)
- Sheol and the place of destruction are in front of Yehowah. How much more so the hearts of the sons of mankind! (**Proverbs 15:11**)
- Then what can I do when God rises up? And when he calls for an **accounting**, what can I answer him? (**Job 31:14**)
- Because he has set a day in which he purposes to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed, and he has furnished a guarantee to all men in that he has resurrected him from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 17:31**)
- This will be in the day when God through Christ Jesus judges the secret **things** of mankind, according to the Good News I declare. (**Romans 2:16**)
- So, then, each of us will render an account for himself to God. (**Romans 14:12**)
- Later they heard the voice of Yehowah God walking in the garden about the breezy part of the day, and the man and his wife went into hiding from the face of Yehowah God in between the trees of the garden. (**Genesis 3:8**)
- And the earth came to be ruined in the **sight** of the true God and the earth became filled with violence. (**Genesis 6:11**)

- And Yehowah proceeded to go down to see the city and the tower that the sons of men had built. (**Genesis 11:5**)
- Then she began to call the name of Yehowah, who was speaking to her; You are a God of sight, for she said; Have I here actually looked upon him who sees me? (**Genesis 16:13**)
- But Sarah began to deny it, saying; I did not laugh! For she was afraid. At this he said; No! But you did laugh. (**Genesis 18:15**)
- And you, you will clear away the guilt of innocent blood from your midst, because you will do what is right in Yehowah's eyes. (**Deuteronomy 21:9**)
- Israel has sinned, and they have also overstepped my covenant that I laid as a command upon them, and they have also taken some of the thing devoted to destruction and have also stolen and also kept it secret and have also put it among their own articles. (**Joshua 7:11**)
- If it was to build for ourselves an altar so as to turn back from following Yehowah, and if it was to offer up burnt offerings and grain offerings on it, and if it was to render up communion sacrifices on it, Yehowah himself will search out. (**Joshua 22:23**)
- And Samuel proceeded to answer Saul and say; I am the seer. Go up before me to the high place, and you men must eat with me today, and I must send you away in the morning, and all that is in your heart I shall tell you. (**1 Samuel 9:19**)
- And what more can David add and speak to you, when you yourself know your servant well, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah? (**2 Samuel 7:20**)
- When the mourning period was past, David immediately sent and took her home to his house, and she came to be his wife. In time she bore to him a son, but the thing that David had done appeared bad in the eyes of Yehowah. (**2 Samuel 11:27**)
- And Yehowah himself had said to Ahijah; Here is the wife of Jeroboam coming to apply for a word from you regarding her son, for he is sick. This way and that is how you should speak to her. And it will occur that as soon as she arrives, she will be making herself unrecognizable. (**1 Kings 14:5**)
- And your sitting quiet and your going out and your coming in I well know, and your exciting yourself against me. (**2 Kings 19:27**)

- What more could David say to you as to honoring your servant, when you yourself know your servant well? (**1 Chronicles 17:18**)
- For, as regards Yehowah, his **eyes** are roving about through all the earth to show his strength in behalf of those whose heart is complete toward him. You **have** acted foolishly respecting this, for from now on there will exist wars against you. (**2 Chronicles 16:9**)
- And Yehowah went on to say to Satan; Have you set your heart upon my servant Job, that there is no one like him in the earth, a man blameless and upright, fearing God and turning aside from bad? (**Job 1:8**)
- If I **have** sinned, what can I accomplish against you, the Observer of mankind? Why is it that you **have** set me as your target, so that I should become a burden to you? (**Job 7:20**)
- Sheol is **naked** in front of him, and the place of destruction has no covering. (**Job 26:6**)
- There is no darkness nor any deep shadow for those practicing what is hurtful to conceal themselves there. (**Job 34:22**)
- Why is it that the wicked one has disrespected God? He has said in his heart; You will not require an accounting. (**Psalms 10:13**)
- Yehowah is in his holy temple. Yehowah, in the heavens is his throne. His own **eyes** behold, his own beaming **eyes** examine the sons of men. (**Psalms 11:4**)
- From the heavens Yehowah has looked, the has seen all the sons of men. (**Psalms 33:13**)
- He is ruling by his mightiness to time indefinite. Upon the nations his own **eyes** keep watch. As for those who are stubborn, let them not be exalted in themselves. (**Psalms 66:7**)
- I **have** kept your orders and your reminders, for all my ways are in front of you. (**Psalms 119:168**)
- O Yehowah, you **have** searched through me, and you know me. (**Psalms 139:1**)
- Even the darkness itself would not prove too dark for you, but night itself would shine just as the day does, the darkness might just as well be the light. (**Psalms 139:12**)
- For the ways of man are in front of the **eyes** of Yehowah, and he is contemplating all his tracks. (**Proverbs 5:21**)

- The **eyes** of Yehowah are in every place, keeping watch upon the bad ones and the good ones. (**Proverbs 15:3**)
- And your sitting quiet and your going out and your coming in I well know, and your exciting yourself against me. (**Isaiah 37:28**)
- And you kept trusting in your badness. You **have** said; There is no one seeing me. Your wisdom and your knowledge, this is what has led you away, and you keep saying in your heart; I am, and there is nobody else. (**Isaiah 47:10**)
- Has this house upon which my name has been called become a mere cave of robbers in **YOUR eyes**? Here I myself also **have** seen it, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 7:11**)
- For my **eyes** are upon all their ways. They **have** not been concealed from before me, neither has their error been hid from in front of my **eyes**. (**Jeremiah 16:17**)
- Or can any man be concealed in places of concealment and I myself not see him, is the utterance of Yehowah? Is it not the heavens and the earth that I myself actually fill, is the utterance of Yehowah? (**Jeremiah 23:24**)
- For the reason that they **have** carried on senselessness in Israel, and they keep committing adultery with the wives of their companions and keep speaking falsely in my own name the word that I did not command them. And I am the One knowing and am a witness, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 29:23**)
- Great in counsel and abundant in acts, you whose **eyes** are opened upon all the ways of the sons of men, in order to give to each one according to his ways and according to the fruitage of his dealings. (**Jeremiah 32:19**)
- He now said to me; Son of man, bore, please, through the wall. And I gradually bored through the wall, and, look! There was a certain entrance. (**Ezekiel 8:8**)
- Then the spirit of Yehowah fell upon me, and he went on to say to me; Say, This is what Yehowah has said; **You** people said the right thing, O house of Israel, and as regards the **things** that come up in **YOUR** spirit, I myself **have** known it. (**Ezekiel 11:5**)
- And he went inside and proceeded to measure the side pillar of the entrance, two cubits, and the entrance, six cubits, and the width of the entrance was seven cubits. (**Ezekiel 41:3**)

- He is revealing the deep **things** and the concealed **things**, knowing what is in the darkness, and with him the light does dwell. (**Daniel 2:22**)
- And it will **have** to become for the people the same as for the priest, and I shall certainly hold an **accounting** against them for their ways, and their dealings I shall bring back upon them. (**Hosea 4:9**)
- Therefore that is what I shall do to you, O Israel. As a consequence of the fact that I shall do this very thing to you, get ready to meet your God, O Israel. (**Amos 4:12**)
- And it must occur at that time that I shall carefully search Jerusalem with lamps, and I will give attention to the men who are congealing upon their dregs and who are saying in their heart, Yehowah will not do good, and he will not do bad. (**Zephaniah 1:12**)
- A pronouncement! The word of Yehowah is against the land of Hadrach, and Damascus is where it rests, for Yehowah has an eye on earthling man and on all the tribes of Israel. (**Zechariah 9:1**)
- But Jesus, having discerned immediately by his spirit that they were reasoning that way in themselves, said to them; Why are **YOU** reasoning these **things** in **YOUR** hearts? (**Mark 2:8**)
- For I am not conscious of anything against myself. Yet by this I am not proved righteous, but he that examines me is Yehowah. (**1 Corinthians 4:4**)
- For at present we see in hazy outline by means of a metal mirror, but then it will be face to face. At present I know partially, but then I shall know accurately even as I am accurately known. (**1 Corinthians 13:12**)
- The sins of some men are publicly **manifest**, leading directly to judgment, but as for other men their sins also become **manifest** later. (**1 Timothy 5:24**)
- As regards whatever our hearts may condemn us in, because God is greater than our hearts and knows all **things**. (**1 John 3:20**)
- And as for the four living creatures, each one of them respectively has six wings, round about and underneath they are full of **eyes**. And they **have** no rest day and night as they say; Holy, holy, holy is Yehowah God, the Almighty, who was and who is and who is coming. (**Revelation 4:8**)
