

GOD'S - SPIRIT - GOD GAVE US A SPIRIT NOT OF COWARDICE

~ **Paul** ... **Teaching** ... **God's Spirit** - God gave us a spirit not of cowardice, but one of love and power and soundness of mind. (**2 Timothy 1:7**) ^[10] - References

2 Timothy 1:7 For God gave us not a spirit of cowardice, but that of power and of love and of soundness of mind.

^[10] - References

- For **you** did not receive a **spirit** of slavery causing fear again, but **you** received a **spirit** of adoption as sons, by which **spirit** we cry out; Abba, Father! (**Romans 8:15**)
- But how, after we had first suffered and been insolently treated, just as **you** know, in Philippi, we mustered up boldness by means of our God to speak to **you** the Good News of God with a great deal of struggling. (**1 Thessalonians 2:2**)
- But as for the cowards and those without faith and those who are disgusting in their filth and murderers and fornicators and those practicing spiritism and idolaters and all the liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulphur. This means the second death. (**Revelation 21:8**)
- And, look! I am sending forth upon **you** that which is promised by my Father. **You**, though, abide in the city until **you** become clothed with **power** from on high. (**Luke 24:49**)
- But **you** will receive **power** when the Holy Spirit arrives upon **you**, and **you** will be witnesses of me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the most distant part of the earth. (**Acts of Apostles 1:8**)
- For the speech about the torture stake is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is God's **power**. (**1 Corinthians 1:18**)
- But that **you** should be made new in the force actuating **YOUR mind**. (**Ephesians 4:23**)

- In that case you will prove successful if you take care to carry out the regulations and the judicial decisions that Yehowah commanded Moses respecting Israel. Be courageous and strong. Do not be afraid nor be terrified. (**1 Chronicles 22:13**)
- Consequently I entreat **YOU** by the compassions of God, brothers, to present **YOUR** bodies a sacrifice living, holy, acceptable to God, a sacred service with **YOUR power** of reason. (**Romans 12:1**)
- There is no fear in **love**, but perfect **love** throws fear outside, because fear exercises a restraint. Indeed, he that is under fear has not been made perfect in **love**. (**1 John 4:18**)
