- God is indeed good to Israel, to those clean in heart. (**Psalms 73:1**)
- The loving-kindnesses of Yehowah I shall mention, the praises of Yehowah, according to all that Yehowah has rendered to us, even the abundant goodness to the house of Israel that he has rendered to them according to his mercies and according to the abundance of his loving-kindnesses. (**Isaiah 63:7**)
- And from time long ago none have heard, nor have any given ear, nor has an eye itself seen a God, except you, that acts for the one that keeps in expectation of him. (**Isaiah 64:4**)
- But just as it is written; Eye has not seen and ear has not heard, neither have there been conceived in the heart of man the things that God has prepared for those who love him. (**1 Corinthians 2:9**)
- At that time our mouth came to be filled with laughter, and our tongue with a joyful cry. At that time they proceeded to say among the nations; Yehowah has done a great thing in what he has done with them. (**Psalms 126:2**)
- O Yehowah, you will adjudge peace to us, because even all our works you have performed for us. (**Isaiah 26:12**)
- For there is no unlucky spell against Jacob, nor any divination against Israel. At this time it may be said respecting Jacob and Israel, What has God worked out! (**Numbers 23:23**)

- On the eighth day he sent the people away, and they began to bless the king and to go to their homes, rejoicing and feeling merry of heart over all the **goodness** that Yehowah had performed for David his servant and for Israel his people. (**1 Kings 8:66**)
- And all the **sons** of Israel were spectators when the fire came down and the glory of Yehowah was upon the house, and they immediately bowed low with their faces to the earth upon the pavement and prostrated themselves and thanked Yehowah, for he is good, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (**2 Chronicles 7:3**)
- For you proceeded to meet him with blessings of good, and to place on his head a crown of refined gold. (**Psalms 21:3**)
- You arrange before me a table in **front** of those showing hostility to me. With oil you **have** greased my head, my cup is well filled. (**Psalms 23:5**)
- His own soul will lodge in **goodness** itself, and his own offspring will take possession of the earth. (**Psalms 25:13**)
- How precious your loving-kindness is, O God! And in the shadow of your wings the **sons** of **men** themselves take **refuge**. (**Psalms 36:7**)
- With the mention of the abundance of your **goodness** they will bubble over, and because of your righteousness they will cry out joyfully. (**Psalms 145:7**)
- And I will saturate the soul of the priests with fatness, and with my **goodness** my own people will become satisfied, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 31:14**)
