James 1:1 James, a slave of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes that are scattered about, greetings.

- Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary, and his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? (**Matthew 13:55**)
- But he motioned to them with his hand to be silent and told them in detail how Yehowah brought him out of the prison, and he said; Report these things to James and the brothers. With that he went out and journeyed to another place. (**Acts of Apostles 12:17**)
- But I saw no one else of the apostles, only James the brother of the **Lord**. (**Galatians 1:19**)
- Do not loiter at **YOUR** business. Be aglow with the spirit. Slave for Yehowah. (**Romans 12:11**)
- For **YOU** know that it is from Yehowah **YOU** will receive the due reward of the inheritance. **SLAVE** for the Master, **Christ**. (**Colossians 3:24**)
- For they themselves keep reporting **about** the way we first entered in among **YOU** and how **YOU** turned to **God** from **YOUR** idols to **slave** for a living and true **God**. (**1 Thessalonians 1:9**)
- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will conclude with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah a New Covenant. (**Jeremiah 31:31**)
- Whereas our **twelve tribes** are hoping to attain to the fulfillment of this promise by intensely rendering him sacred service night and day. Concerning this hope I am accused by Jews, O king. (**Acts of Apostles 26:7**)

- As it was, there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, reverent men, from every nation of those under heaven. (**Acts of Apostles 2:5**)
- Saul, for his part, was approving of the murder of him. On that day great persecution arose against the congregation that was in Jerusalem, all except the apostles were **scattered** throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria. (**Acts of Apostles 8:1**)
- Peter, an apostle of **Jesus Christ**, to the temporary residents **scattered about** in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, to the ones chosen (**1 Peter 1:1**)
