

1 Chronicles 15:15· Then the sons of the Levites began to carry the ark of the true God, just as Moses had commanded by Yehowah's word, upon their shoulders with the rods upon them.

[10] - References:

- And you must put the poles through the rings upon the sides of the Ark in order to **carry** the Ark with them. (**Exodus 25:14**)
- Then he put the poles through the rings on the sides of the Ark for carrying the Ark. (**Exodus 37:5**)
- And they must put a covering of sealskins over it and spread out an entire cloth of blue on top and put in its poles. (**Numbers 4:6**)
- But the poles were long, so that the tips of the poles were visible at the Holy in front of the innermost room, but they were not visible outside, and they continue there down to this day. (**2 Chronicles 5:9**)
- And you must make poles of acacia wood and overlay them with gold. (**Exodus 25:13**)
- But to the sons of Kohath he gave none, because the service of the holy place was upon them. They did their carrying on the shoulder. (**Numbers 7:9**)
- At that particular time Yehowah separated the tribe of Levi to **carry** the **ark** of **Yehowah's** covenant, to stand before Yehowah for ministering to him and to bless in his name until this day. (**Deuteronomy 10:8**)
- And it came about that when the carriers of the **ark** of Yehowah had marched six steps, he immediately sacrificed a bull and a fatling. (**2 Samuel 6:13**)
- It was then that David said; No one is to **carry** the **ark** of the **true God** but the **Levites**, for they are the ones whom Yehowah has chosen to **carry** the **ark** of Yehowah and to minister to him to time indefinite. (**1 Chronicles 15:2**)
- So all the older men of Israel came, and the **Levites** began to **carry** the Ark. (**2 Chronicles 5:4**)
