- Exalt Yehowah our God and bow down yourselves at his footstool, he is holy. (Psalms 99:5)
- O how Yehowah in his anger beclouds the daughter of Zion! He has thrown down from heaven to earth the beauty of Israel. And he has not remembered his footstool in the day of his anger. (Lamentations 2:1)
- And He went on to say to me; Son of man, this is the place of my throne and the place of the soles of my feet, where I shall reside in the midst of the sons of Israel to time indefinite, and no more will they, the house of Israel, defile my holy name, they and their kings, by their fornication and by the carcasses of their kings at their death.
