- **And here are the divisions of the priests and of the Levites for all the service of the house of the true God, and with you in all the work there is every willing one with skill for all the service, and also the princes and all the people, for all your words. (1 Chronicles 28:21)**
- **And David proceeded to congregate all the princes of Israel, the princes of the tribes and the princes of the divisions of those ministering to the king and the chiefs of thousands and the chiefs of hundreds and the chiefs of all the goods and livestock of the king and of his sons, together with the court officials and the mighty men, even every valiant, mighty man, to Jerusalem. (1 Chronicles 28:1)**
- **Meantime, sons were born to David in Hebron, and his firstborn came to be Amnon by Ahinoam the Jezreelitess. (2 Samuel 3:2)**
- **And there were these born to him in Jerusalem; Shimea and Shobab and Nathan and Solomon, four of Bath-sheba the daughter of Ammiel. (1 Chronicles 3:5)**
- **At that the king answered and said; You men, give her the living child, and you must by no means put him to death. She is his mother. (1 Kings 3:27)**
