- Hence Abraham **said** to his servant, the oldest one of his household, who was managing all he had; Put your hand, please, under my thigh. **(Genesis 24:2)**
- Besides, in this case, what is looked for in **stewards** is for a man to be found **faithful**. **(1 Corinthians 4:2)**
- So, then, brothers, stand firm and maintain **YOUR** hold on the traditions that **YOU** were taught, whether it was through a verbal message or through a letter of ours. **(2 Thessalonians 2:15)**
- In proportion as each one has received a gift, use it in ministering to one another as fine **stewards** of God's undeserved kindness expressed in various ways. **(1 Peter 4:10)**
- So now let Pharaoh look for a man **discreet** and wise and set him over the land of Egypt. **(Genesis 41:33)**
- Get wise and **discreet** and experienced men of **YOUR** tribes, that I may set them as heads over **YOU**. **(Deuteronomy 1:13)**
- Who **really** is the **faithful** and **discreet** slave whom his **master** appointed over his domestics, to give them their **food** at the **proper** time? **(Matthew 24:45)**
- His **master said** to him; Well done, good and **faithful** slave! You were **faithful** over a few things. **I will appoint** you over many things. Enter into the joy of your master. **(Matthew 25:21)**

- So he **said** to him; Well done, good slave! Because in a very small matter you have proved yourself **faithful**, hold authority over ten cities. (**Luke 19:17**)
- Then I put Shelemiah the priest and Zadok the copyist and Pedaiah of the Levites in charge of the stores, and under their control there was Hanan the son of Zaccur the son of Mattaniah, for they were considered **faithful**, and upon them it devolved to do the distributing to their brothers. (**Nehemiah 13:13**)
- My eyes are upon the **faithful** ones of the earth, that they may dwell with me. The one walking in a faultless way, he it is who **will** minister to me. (**Psalms 101:6**)
- They are thinking of making my people forget my name by means of their dreams that they **keep** relating each one to the other, just as their fathers forgot my name by means of Baal. (**Jeremiah 23:27**)
- The prophet with whom there is a dream, let him relate the dream, but the one with whom my own word is, let him speak forth my word truthfully. What does the straw have to do with the grain? is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:28**)
- Let a man so appraise us as being subordinates of Christ and **stewards** of sacred secrets of God. (**1 Corinthians 4:1**)
