John 3:35... **The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand.**

- For the Father **has** affection for the **Son** and shows him all the **things** he himself does, and he will show him works greater than these, in order, that **you** may marvel. (**John 5:20**)
- Just as the Father **has** loved me and I have loved **you**, remain in my love. (**John 15:9**)
- All **things** have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the **Son** but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father but the **Son** and anyone to whom the **Son** is willing to reveal him. (**Matthew 11:27**)
- And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority **has** been **given** me in heaven and on the earth. (**Matthew 28:18**)
- All **things** have been delivered to me by my Father, and who the **Son** is no one knows but the Father, and who the Father is, no one knows but the **Son**, and he to whom the **Son** is willing to reveal him. (**Luke 10:22**)
- According as you have **given** him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have **given** him, he may give them everlasting life. (**John 17:2**)
- The way of the wicked one is something detestable to Yehowah, but the one pursuing righteousness he **loves**. (**Proverbs 15:9**)
- And to him there were **given** rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership that will not pass away, and his kingdom one that will not be brought to ruin. (**Daniel 7:14**)

- In order that all may honor the **Son** just as they honor the Father. He that does not honor the **Son** does not honor the Father who sent him. (**John 5:23**)
- All the **things** that the Father **has** are mine. That is why I said he receives from what is mine and declares it to **you**. (**John 16:15**)
- Therefore let all the house of Israel know for a certainty that God made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom **you** impaled. (**Acts of Apostles 2:36**)
- But when all **things** will have been subjected to him, then the **Son** himself will also subject himself to the One who subjected all **things** to him, that God may be all **things** to everyone. (**1 Corinthians 15:28**)
