- The **Father** loves the **Son** and has given all **things** into his hand. (**John 3:35**)
- According as you **have** given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you **have** given him, he may give them everlasting life. (**John 17:2**)
- For God subjected all **things** under his feet. But when he says that all **things have** been subjected, it is evident that it is with the exception of the one who subjected all **things** to him. (**1 Corinthians 15:27**)
- No man has seen God at any time, the only-begotten god who is in the bosom position with the **Father** is the one that has explained him. (**John 1:18**)
- And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (**Matthew 28:18**)
- All **things have** been **delivered** to me by my **Father**, and who the **Son** is no one **knows** but the **Father**, and who the **Father** is, no one **knows** but the **Son**, and he to whom the **Son** is **willing** to **reveal** him. (**Luke 10:22**)
- Just as the **Father knows** me and I **know** the **Father**, and I surrender my soul in behalf of the sheep. (**John 10:15**)

- But we **know** that the **Son** of God has come, and he has given us intellectual capacity that we may gain the knowledge of the true one. And we are in union with the true one, by means of his **Son** Jesus Christ. This is the true God and life everlasting. (**1 John 5:20**)
- The **things** concealed belong to Yehowah our God, but the **things** revealed belong to us and to our sons to time indefinite, that we may carry out all the words of this Law. (**Deuteronomy 29:29**)
- The fear of Yehowah is the start of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Most Holy One is what understanding is. (**Proverbs 9:10**)
- In response Jesus said to him; Happy you are, Simon son of Jonah, because flesh and blood did not **reveal** it to you, but my **Father** who is in the heavens did. (**Matthew 16:17**)
- For the **Father** judges no one at all, but he has committed all the judging to the **Son**. (**John 5:22**)
- Not that any man has seen the **Father**, except he who is from God, this one has seen the **Father**. (**John 6:46**)
- I **know** him, because I am a representative from him, and that One sent me forth. (**John 7:29**)
- Therefore they went on to say to him; Where is your Father? Jesus answered; **You know** neither me nor my **Father**. If **you** did **know** me, **you** would **know** my **Father** also. (**John 8:19**)
- He, knowing that the **Father** had given all **things** into his hands and that he came forth from God and was going to God. (**John 13:3**)
- If **you** men had known me, **you** would **have** known my **Father** also, from this moment on **you know** him and **have** seen him. (**John 14:7**)
- All the **things** that the **Father** has are mine. That is why I said he receives from what is mine and declares it to **you**. (**John 16:15**)
- Righteous **Father**, the world has, indeed, not come to **know** you, but I **have** come to **know** you, and these **have** come to **know** that you sent me forth. (**John 17:25**)
- Jude, a slave of Jesus Christ, but a brother of James, to the called ones who are loved in relationship with God the **Father** and preserved for Jesus Christ. (**Jude 1:1**)
