- But become kind to one another, tenderly compassionate, freely forgiving one another just as God also by Christ freely forgave YOU. (**Ephesians 4:32**)
- Continue putting up with one another and forgiving one another freely if anyone has a cause for complaint against another. Even as Yehowah freely forgave YOU, so do YOU also. (**Colossians 3:13**)
- As far off as the sunrise is from the sunset, so far off from us he has put our transgressions. (**Psalms 103:12**)
- And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. (**Matthew 6:12**)
- If, then, you are bringing your gift to the altar and you there remember that your brother has something against you. (**Matthew 5:23**)
- Jesus said to him; I say to you, not, up to seven times, but, up to seventy-seven times. (**Matthew 18:22**)
- In like manner my heavenly Father will also deal with YOU if YOU do not forgive each one his brother from YOUR hearts. (**Matthew 18:35**)
- Moreover, stop judging, and YOU will by no means be judged, and stop condemning, and YOU will by no means be condemned. Keep on releasing, and YOU will be released. (**Luke 6:37**)

- And **forgive** us our sins, for we ourselves also **forgive** everyone that is in debt to us, and do not bring us into temptation. (**Luke 11:4**)
