- Pay attention to yourselves. If your **brother** commits a sin give him a rebuke, and if he repents **forgive** him. (**Luke 17:3**)
- But become kind to one another, tenderly compassionate, freely forgiving one another just as God also by Christ freely forgave **YOU**. (**Ephesians 4:32**)

· This is what **you** are to say to Joseph; I beseech you, pardon, please, the revolt of your **brothers** and their sin in that they have rendered evil to you. And now pardon, please, the revolt of the servants of your father's God. And Joseph burst into tears when they spoke to him. (**Genesis 50:17**)

· And you **will** have to know that I myself, Yehowah, have heard all your disrespectful things that you have said concerning the mountains of Israel, saying; They have been laid desolate. To us they have been given for food. (**Ezekiel 35:12**)

· Whereas if **you** do not **forgive** men their trespasses, neither **will YOUR Father forgive YOUR** trespasses. (**Matthew 6:15**)
