**John 3:16** For God loved the world so much that he gave his only-begotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him might not be destroyed but have everlasting life.

- The love is in this respect, not that we **have loved** God, but that he **loved** us and sent forth his **Son** as a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins. (**1 John 4:10**)
- As for us, we love, because he first **loved** us. (**1 John 4:19**)
- And he went on to say; Take, please, your son, your only son whom you so love, Isaac, and make a trip to the land of Moriah and there offer him up as a burnt offering on one of the mountains that I shall designate to you. (**Genesis 22:2**)
- And to say; By myself I do swear, is the utterance of Yehowah, that by reason of the fact that you **have** done this thing and you **have** not withheld your son, your only one. (**Genesis 22:16**)
- But God recommends his own love to us in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (**Romans 5:8**)
- He who did not even spare his own **Son** but delivered him up for us all, why will he not also with him kindly give us all other things? (**Romans 8:32**)
- By this the love of God was made manifest in our case, because God sent forth his **only-begotten Son** into the **world** that we **might** gain **life** through him. (**1 John 4:9**)
- However, as many as did receive him, to them he **gave** authority to become God's children, because they were **exercising faith** in his name. (**John 1:12**)

- However, Jesus cried out and said; He that puts **faith** in me puts **faith**, not in me only, but in him also that sent me. (**John 12:44**)
- One Lord, one **faith**, one baptism. (**Ephesians 4:5**)
- Because to **YOU** the privilege was given in behalf of Christ, not only to put **YOUR faith** in him, but also to suffer in his behalf. (**Philippians 1:29**)
- And that from infancy you **have** known the holy writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through the **faith** in connection with Christ Jesus. (**2 Timothy 3:15**)
- And these will depart into **everlasting** cutting-off, but the righteous ones into **everlasting** life. (**Matthew 25:46**)
- For this is the will of my Father, that **everyone** that beholds the **Son** and exercises **faith** in him should **have everlasting life**, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (**John 6:40**)
- But these **have** been written down that **YOU** may believe that Jesus is the Christ the **Son** of God, and that, because of believing, **YOU** may **have life** by means of his name. (**John 20:31**)
- For the wages sin pays is death, but the gift God gives is **everlasting life** by Christ Jesus our Lord. (**Romans 6:23**)
- I write **YOU** these things that **YOU** may know that **YOU have life everlasting**, **YOU** who put **YOUR faith** in the name of the **Son** of God. (**1 John 5:13**)
- For on this day atonement will be made for **YOU** to pronounce **YOU** clean. **YOU** will be clean from all **YOUR** sins before Yehowah. (**Leviticus 16:30**)
- What is mortal man that you keep him in mind, and the son of earthling man that you take care of him? (**Psalms 8:4**)
- For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (**Isaiah 9:6**)
- Turn to me and be saved, all **YOU** at the ends of the earth, for I am God, and there is no one else. (**Isaiah 45:22**)
- Look! As a witness to the national groups I **have** given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (**Isaiah 55:4**)

- At this the owner of the vineyard said; What shall I do? I will send my son the beloved. Likely they will respect this one. (Luke 20:13)
- So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an **only-begotten** son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (John 1:14)
- He that exercises **faith** in the **Son** has **everlasting life**, he that disobeys the **Son** will not see **life**, but the wrath of God remains upon him. (John 3:36)
- Most truly I say to **you**, he that hears my word and believes him that sent me has **everlasting life**, and he does not come into judgment but has passed over from death to **life**. (John 5:24)
- Hence Jesus said to them; Most truly I say to **you**, Moses did not give **you** the bread from heaven, but my Father does give **you** the true bread from heaven. (John 6:32)
- Most truly I say to **you**, he that believes has **everlasting life**. (John 6:47)
- Jesus said to them; If God were **YOUR** Father, **YOU** would love me, for from God I came forth and am here. Neither **have** I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth. (John 8:42)
- But if anyone hears my sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him, for I came, not to judge the **world**, but to save the **world**. (John 12:47)
- They said; Believe on the Lord Jesus and you will get saved, you and your household. (Acts of Apostles 16:31)
- To what end? That, just as sin ruled as king with death, likewise also undeserved kindness **might** rule as king through righteousness with **everlasting life** in view through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 5:21)
- But thanks to God, for he gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! (1 Corinthians 15:57)
- Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus through God's will according to the promise of the **life** that is in union with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 1:1)
- And after he had been made perfect he became responsible for **everlasting** salvation to all those obeying him. (Hebrews 5:9)

- But my righteous one will live by reason of faith, and, if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him. (**Hebrews 10:38**)
- By **faith** Abraham, when he was tested, as good as offered up Isaac, and the man that had gladly received the promises attempted to offer up his **only-begotten** son. (**Hebrews 11:17**)
- See what sort of love the Father has given us, so that we should be called children of God, and such we are. That is why the **world** does not **have** a knowledge of us, because it has not come to know him. (**1 John 3:1**)
- By this we **have** come to know love, because that one surrendered his soul for us, and we are under obligation to surrender our souls for our brothers. (**1 John 3:16**)
- And we ourselves **have** come to know and **have** believed the love that God has in our case. God is love, and he that remains in love remains in union with God and God remains in union with him. (**1 John 4:16**)
- To the only God our Savior through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, **might** and authority for all past eternity and now and into all eternity. Amen. (**Jude 1:25**)
