· Consequently Yehowah saw that the badness of man was abundant in the earth and every inclination of the thoughts of his **heart** was only bad all the time. **(Genesis 6:5)**

· And Yehowah began to smell a restful odor, and so Yehowah said in his **heart**; Never again shall I call down evil upon the ground on man's account, because the inclination of the **heart** of man is bad from his youth up, and never again shall I deal every living thing a blow just as I have done. **(Genesis 8:21)**

· The senseless one has said in his **heart**; There is no Yehowah. They have acted ruinously, they have acted detestably in their dealing. There is no one doing good. **(Psalms 14:1)**

· The **heart** is more treacherous than anything else and is desperate. Who can know it? **(Jeremiah 17:9)**

· Now the works of the flesh are manifest, and they are fornication, uncleanness, loose conduct. **(Galatians 5:19)**

· For example, **out** of the **heart** come wicked **reasonings, murders, adulteries, fornications, thieveries, false testimonies, blasphemies.** **(Matthew 15:19)**

· However, Esau harbored animosity for Jacob on account of the blessing with which his father had blessed him, and Esau kept saying in his **heart**; The days of the period of mourning for my father are getting closer. After that I am going to kill Jacob my brother. **(Genesis 27:41)**

· So he wrote in the letter, saying; **Put** Uriah in front of the heaviest battle charges, and **you men** must retreat from behind him, and he must be struck down and die. **(2 Samuel 11:15)**

- More than all else that is to be guarded, safeguard your **heart**, for **out** of it are the sources of life. (**Proverbs 4:23**)
- And defraud no widow or fatherless boy, no alien resident or afflicted one, and scheme **out** nothing bad against one another in **YOUR** hearts. (**Zechariah 7:10**)
- But I say to **YOU** that everyone that keeps on looking at a woman so as to have a passion for her has already committed adultery with her in his **heart**. (**Matthew 5:28**)
- However, I say to **YOU** that everyone divorcing his wife, except on account of fornication, makes her a subject for adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery. (**Matthew 5:32**)
- They have eyes full of adultery and unable to desist from sin, and they entice unsteady souls. They have a **heart** trained in covetousness. They are accursed children. (**2 Peter 2:14**)
