- For just as **Jonah** became a sign to the Ninevites, in the same way **will** the Son of man be also to this **generation**. (**Luke 11:30**)
- And the uncircumcised person that is such by nature **will**, by carrying out the Law, judge you who with its written code and circumcision are a transgressor of Law. (**Romans 2:27**)
- And the men of **Nineveh** began to put faith in God, and they proceeded to proclaim a fast and to put on sackcloth, from the greatest one of them even to the least one of them. (**Jonah 3:5**)
- Out of that land he went forth into Assyria and set himself to building **Nineveh** and RehobothIr and Calah (**Genesis 10:11**)
- Not to numerous peoples unintelligible in language or heavy in tongue, whose words you cannot hear understandingly. If it was to them that I had sent you, those very ones would listen to you. (**Ezekiel 3:6**)
- And as for Samaria, she has not sinned even up to half of your sins, but you kept making your detestable things abound more than they did, so that you made your sisters appear righteous because of all your detestable things that you carried on. (**Ezekiel 16:51**)
- Get up, go to **Nineveh** the great city, and proclaim against her that their badness has come up before me. (**Jonah 1:2**)
- When the word reached the king of **Nineveh**, then he rose up from his throne and put off his official garment from himself and covered himself with sackcloth and sat down in the ashes. (**Jonah 3:6**)

- Truly I say to **you**, it **will** be more enduring for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah on Judgment Day than for that city. (**Matthew 10:15**)
- With whom shall I compare this **generation**? It is like young children sitting in the marketplaces who cry out to their playmates. (**Matthew 11:16**)
- Consequently I say to **you** people, it **will** be more enduring for the land of Sodom on Judgment Day than for you. (**Matthew 11:24**)
