Matthew 6:10 Let your kingdom come. Let your will take place, as in heaven, also upon earth.

- And in the days of those kings the God of **heaven will** set up a **kingdom** that **will** never be brought to ruin. And the **kingdom** itself **will** not be passed on to any other people. It **will** crush and put an end to all these **kingdoms**, and it itself **will** stand to times indefinite. (**Daniel 2:44**)
- Keep on, then, seeking first the **kingdom** and his righteousness, and all these other things **will** be added to **you**. (**Matthew 6:33**)
- And the seventh angel blew his trumpet. And loud voices occurred in **heaven**, saying; The **kingdom** of the world did become the **kingdom** of our Lord and of his Christ, and he **will** rule as king forever and ever. (**Revelation 11:15**)
- Again, for the second time, he went off and prayed, saying; My Father, if it is not possible for this to pass away except I drink it, let your **will take** place. (**Matthew 26:42**)
- You are worthy, Yehowah, even our God, to receive the glory and the honor and the power, because you created all things, and because of your **will** they existed and were created. (**Revelation 4:11**)
- And just a little while longer, and the wicked one **will** be no more, and you **will** certainly give attention to his **place**, and he **will** not be. (**Psalms 37:10**)
- And he said to him; Truly I tell you today, you **will** be with me in Paradise. (**Luke 23:43**)
- And I have hope toward God, which hope these men themselves also entertain, that there is going to be a resurrection of both the righteous and the unrighteous. (**Acts of Apostles 24:15**)

- Whose **will** is that all sorts of men should be saved and **come** to an accurate knowledge of truth. (**1 Timothy 2:4**)
- But the thing was bad in the eyes of Samuel inasmuch as they had said; Do give us a king to judge us, and Samuel began to pray to Yehowah. (**1 Samuel 8:6**)
- Yours, O Yehowah, are the greatness and the mightiness and the beauty and the excellency and the dignity, for everything in the **heavens** and in the **earth** is yours. Yours is the **kingdom**, O Yehowah, the One also lifting yourself up as head over all. (**1 Chronicles 29:11**)
- Unless Yehowah himself builds the house, it is to no avail that its builders have worked hard on it. Unless Yehowah himself guards the city, it is to no avail that the guard has kept awake. (**Psalms 127:1**)
- As for the four, each one had four faces and each one had four wings, and the likeness of the hands of earthling man was under their wings. (**Ezekiel 10:21**)
- And this Good News of the **kingdom will** be preached in all the inhabited **earth** for a witness to all the nations, and then the end **will come**. (**Matthew 24:14**)
- Then he said to them; Whenever **you** pray, say; Father, let your name be sanctified. **Let your kingdom come**. (**Luke 11:2**)
- Saying; Father, if you wish, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, let, not my **will**, but yours **take** place. (**Luke 22:42**)
