Matthew 6:25 On this account I say to you; Stop being anxious about YOUR souls as to what YOU will eat or what YOU will drink, or about YOUR bodies as to what YOU will wear. Does not the soul mean more than food and the body than clothing?

- Then he said to his disciples; On this account I say to you, quit being anxious about YOUR souls as to what YOU will eat or about YOUR bodies as to what YOU will wear. (**Luke 12:22**)
- Do not be anxious over anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication along with thanksgiving let YOUR petitions be made known to God. (**Philippians 4:6**)
- Throw your burden upon Yehowah himself, and he himself will sustain you. Never will he allow the righteous one to totter. (**Psalms 55:22**)
- So, having sustenance and covering, we shall be content with these things. (**1 Timothy 6:8**)
- Let YOUR manner of life be free of the love of money, while YOU are content with the present things. For he has said; I will by no means leave you nor by any means forsake you. (**Hebrews 13:5**)
- While YOU throw all YOUR anxiety upon him, because he cares for YOU. (**1 Peter 5:7**)
- For the soul is worth more than food and the body than clothing. (**Luke 12:23**)
- But in case YOU should say; What are we going to eat in the seventh year seeing that we may not sow seed or gather our crops? (**Leviticus 25:20**)

- What is mortal man that you keep him in mind, and the son of earthling man that you take care of him? (**Psalms 8:4**)
- Anxious care in the heart of a man is **what will** cause it to bow down, but the good word is **what** makes it rejoice. (**Proverbs 12:25**)
- For a dream certainly comes in because of abundance of occupation, and the voice of a stupid one because of the abundance of words. (**Ecclesiastes 5:3**)
- Sweet is the sleep of the one serving, regardless of whether it is little or much that he **eats**, but the plenty belonging to the rich one is not permitting him to sleep. (**Ecclesiastes 5:12**)
- But the anxieties of this system of things and the deceptive power of riches and the desires for the rest of the things make inroads and choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful. (**Mark 4:19**)
- But pay attention to yourselves that **YOUR** hearts never become weighed down with overeating and heavy drinking and anxieties of life, and suddenly that day be instantly upon **YOU**. (**Luke 21:34**)
