Psalms 106:26... So he proceeded to raise his hand in an oath concerning them, that he would make them fall in the wilderness,

[10] - References

- And I shall certainly bring you into the land that I raised my hand in oath to give to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, and I shall indeed give it to you as something to possess. I am Yehowah. (Exodus 6:8)
- So I swore in my anger: They shall not enter into my rest. (Hebrews 3:11)
- In this wilderness YOUR carcasses will fall, yes, all YOUR registered ones of all YOUR number from twenty years old upward, YOU who have murmured against me. (Numbers 14:29)
- Will never see the land about which I swore to their fathers, yes, all those treating me without respect will not see it. (Numbers 14:23)
- But the carcasses of you yourselves will fall in this wilderness. (Numbers 14:32)
- And the days that we walked from Kadesh-barnea until we crossed the torrent valley of Zered were thirty-eight years, until all the generation of the men of war had come to their end from the midst of the camp, just as Yehowah had sworn to them. (Deuteronomy 2:14)
- For the sons of Israel had walked forty years in the wilderness, until all the nation of the men of war who came out of Egypt that did not listen to the voice of Yehowah had come to its finish, to whom Yehowah swore that he would never let them see the land that Yehowah had sworn to their forefathers to give to us, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Joshua 5:6)
- And I myself also lifted up my hand in an oath to them in the wilderness, not to bring them into the land that I had given, one

flowing with milk and honey, it is the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:15)
