

## KING - MAKE A HANDWRITTEN COPY OF THE LAW

~ **Moses** ... **Statement** ... **King Makes Handwritten Copy Of Law** - Your king must make a handwritten copy of the Law from the priests for himself. (**Deuteronomy 17:18**) <sup>[12]</sup> - [References](#)

**Deuteronomy 17:18** And it must occur that when he takes his seat on the throne of his kingdom, he must write in a book for himself a copy of this Law from that which is in the charge of the priests, the Levites.

- Then Moses wrote this **Law** and gave it to the **priests** the sons of Levi, the carriers of the ark of Yehowah's covenant, and to all the older men of Israel. (**Deuteronomy 31:9**)
- Taking this **book** of the **Law**, **you must** place it at the side of the ark of the covenant of Yehowah **YOUR** God, and it **must** serve as a witness there against you. (**Deuteronomy 31:26**)
- Later Hilkiyah the High Priest said to Shaphan the secretary; The very **book** of the **Law** I have found in the house of Yehowah. So Hilkiyah gave the **book** to Shaphan, and he began to read it. (**2 Kings 22:8**)
- In the region of the Jordan in the land of Moab Moses undertook to explain this **Law**, saying; (**Deuteronomy 1:5**)
- Now this is the **Law** that Moses set before the sons of Israel. (**Deuteronomy 4:44**)
- And **you must** be very courageous to keep and to do all that is written in the **book** of the **Law** of Moses by never turning away from it to the right or to the left. (**Joshua 23:6**)
- Then they brought the king's son out and put upon him the diadem and the Testimony and made him king, and so Jehoiada and his sons anointed him and said; Let the king live! (**2 Chronicles 23:11**)
- Now while they were bringing out the money that was being brought to the house of Yehowah, Hilkiyah the priest found the **book** of Yehowah's **Law** by the hand of Moses. (**2 Chronicles 34:14**)

- Inasmuch as from before the king and his seven counselors an order was sent to investigate concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the **Law** of your God that is in your hand. (**Ezra 7:14**)
- Accordingly Ezra the priest brought the **Law** before the congregation of men as well as of women and of all intelligent enough to listen, on the first day of the seventh month. (**Nehemiah 8:2**)
- Also, your reminders are what I am fond of, as men of my counsel. (**Psalms 119:24**)
- Inspired decision should be upon the lips of a king, in judgment his mouth should not prove unfaithful. (**Proverbs 16:10**)
