- And the Jebusite and the Amorite and the Girgashite. (**Genesis 10:16**)
- And Abram went on through the land as far as the site of Shechem, near the big trees of Moreh, and at that time the Canaanite was in the land. (**Genesis 12:6**)
- The Amalekites are dwelling in the land of the Negeb, and the Hittites and the Jebusites and the **Amorites** are dwelling in the mountainous region, and the **Canaanites** are dwelling by the **sea** and by the side of the Jordan. (**Numbers 13:29**)
- The five axis lords of the Philistines, and all the **Canaanites**, even the Sidonians and the Hivites inhabiting Mount Lebanon from Mount Baal-hermon as far as to the entering in of Hamath. (**Judges 3:3**)
- At that time the sheiks of Edom will indeed be disturbed, As for the despots of Moab, trembling will take hold on them. All the inhabitants of Canaan will indeed be disheartened. (**Exodus 15:15**)
- And she went on to say to the men; I do know that **Yehowah** will certainly give **YOU** the land, and that the fright of **YOU** has fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land have become disheartened because of **YOU**. (**Joshua 2:9**)

- When we got to hear it, then our hearts began to melt, and no spirit has arisen yet in anybody because of YOU, for Yehowah YOUR God is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath. (Joshua 2:11)
- And they went on to say to Joshua; Yehowah has given all the land into our hand. Consequently all the inhabitants of the land have also grown disheartened because of us. (Joshua 2:24)
- And they will be bound to tell it to the inhabitants of this land. They have heard that you are Yehowah in among this people, who has appeared face to face. You are Yehowah, and your cloud is standing over them, and you are going before them in the pillar of cloud by day and in the pillar of fire by night. (Numbers 14:14)
- No man will make a firm stand against YOU. The dread of YOU and the fear of YOU Yehowah YOUR God will put before the face of all the land on which YOU will tread, just as he has promised YOU. (Deuteronomy 11:25)
- And all the peoples of the earth will have to see that Yehowah's name has been called upon you, and they will indeed be afraid of you. (Deuteronomy 28:10)
- Then they answered Joshua and said; It was because your servants were plainly told that Yehowah your God had commanded Moses his servant to give YOU all the land and to annihilate all the inhabitants of the land from before YOU, and we became very much afraid for our souls because of YOU. So we did this thing. (Joshua 9:24)
- He became very much afraid, because Gibeon was a great city, like one of the royal cities, and because it was greater than Ai, and all its men were mighty ones. (Joshua 10:2)
- And the food of his table and the sitting of his servants and the table service of his waiters and their attire and his drinks and his burnt sacrifices that he regularly offered up at the house of Yehowah, then there proved to be no more spirit in her. (1 Kings 10:5)
- Further, they struck all the cities round about Gerar, for the dread of Yehowah had come to be upon them, and they went plundering all the cities, for there happened to be much to plunder in them. (2 Chronicles 14:14)
- When my spirit fainted away within me. Then you yourself knew my roadway. In the path in which I walk they have hidden a trap for me. (Psalms 142:3)
