(**Joshua 7:24**)
- He will repay the bad to my foes, in your trueness silence them. (**Psalms 54:5**)
- I have soothed myself until the morning. Like a lion, so he keeps breaking all my **bones**, from daylight till night you keep handing me over. (**Isaiah 38:13**)

- But when Esther came in **before** the king he said with the written document. Let his bad scheme that he has schemed against the Jews come back upon his own head, and they hanged him and his **sons** upon the stake. (**Esther 9:25**)
- By the transgression of the lips the bad person is ensnared, but the righteous one gets out of distress. (**Proverbs 12:13**)
- Do not slander a servant to his master, that he may not call down evil upon you, and that you may not have to be held guilty. (**Proverbs 30:10**)
- All the high officials of the kingdom, the prefects and the satraps, the high royal officers and the governors, have taken counsel together to establish a royal statute and to enforce an interdict, that whoever makes a petition to any god or man for thirty days except to you, O king, should be thrown to the **lions' pit**. (**Daniel 6:7**)
- Then it was that they approached and were saying **before** the king concerning the interdict of the king; Is there not an interdict that you have signed that any man that asks a petition from any god or man for thirty days except from you, O king, he should be thrown to the **lions' pit**? The king was answering and saying; The matter is well established according to the Law of the Medes and the Persians, which is not annulled. (**Daniel 6:12**)
