- Look! I shall certainly do according to your words. Look! I shall certainly give you a wise and understanding **heart**, so that one like you there has not happened to be before you, and after you there will not rise up one like you. (**1 Kings 3:12**)

- Who have said to the ones seeing, **you** must not see, and to the ones having visions, **you** must not envision for us any straightforward things. Speak to us smooth things, envision deceptive things. (**Isaiah 30:10**)
- Ephraim is feeding on wind and chasing after the east wind all day long. Lying and despoiling are what he multiplies. And a covenant with Assyria they conclude, and to Egypt oil itself is brought. (**Hosea 12:1**)
- Wisdom is the prime thing. Acquire wisdom, and with all that you acquire, acquire understanding. (**Proverbs 4:7**)
- The **heart** of the understanding one acquires **knowledge**, and the ear of wise ones seeks to find **knowledge**. (**Proverbs 18:15**)

- **Incline your ear and hear the words of the wise ones, that you may apply your very heart to my knowledge. (Proverbs 22:17)**
- **As for the appearance of the wheels and their structure, it was like the glow of chrysolite, and the four of them had one likeness. And their appearance and their structure were just as when a wheel proved to be in the midst of a wheel. (Ezekiel 1:16)**
