[Question] What will be the situation, at the beginning of the thousand year reign of Christ?

2• And just a little while longer, and the wicked one will be no more, and you will certainly give attention to his place, and he will not be. (Psalms 37:10)

[Question] Who then will be no more, and what will people give attention to?

3• Give a glad cry, you heavens, and be joyful, you earth. Let the mountains become cheerful with a glad outcry. For Yehowah has comforted his people, and he shows pity upon his own afflicted ones. (Isaiah 49:13)

[Question] Why will the earth then be joyful, and the mountains cry out joyfully?

4• And as for the nation that will bring its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon and actually serve him, I will also let it rest upon its ground, is the utterance of Yehowah, and it will certainly cultivate it and dwell in it. (Jeremiah 27:11)

[Question] What promise did Yehowah make, to any nation, that agreed to come in under the yoke of Babylon?

5• And over Babylon the heavens and the earth and all that is in them will certainly cry out joyfully, for out of the north there will come to her the despoilers, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 51:48)

[Question] Where would Yehowah bring forth the ones, to free his people from Babylon?

6• Shout in triumph to Yehowah, all you people of the earth. Be cheerful and cry out joyfully and make melody. (Psalms

98:4)

[Question] How then, will all the peoples of the earth feel?

- 7· **At that time our mouth came to be filled with laughter, and our tongue with a joyful cry. At that time they proceeded to say among the nations; Yehowah has done a great thing in what he has done with them. (Psalms 126:2)**

[Question] What great thing then, will Yehowah alone do for the peoples of the earth?

- 8· **Because of the goodness of the righteous ones a town is elated, but when the wicked ones perish there is a joyful cry. (Proverbs 11:10)**

[Question] How do people feel when wicked ones perish?

[Question] Who is the very progenitor of wickedness?

- 9· **Be glad over her, O heaven, also YOU holy ones and YOU apostles and YOU prophets, because God has judicially exacted punishment for YOU from her! (Revelation 18:20)**
