

**Isaiah 19:21~ And Yehowah will certainly become known to the Egyptians, and the Egyptians must know Yehowah in that day, and they must render sacrifice and gift and must make a vow to Yehowah and pay it.**

**1• In that day many Egyptians will come up to the house of Yehowah, in order to learn of his ways, and bring gifts and render sacrifices. With his ways no longer obscured by false religion, the time will be refreshingly bright and clear.**

**[Question]** What will Egyptians then do regarding Yehowah's worship and his house?

**2• And I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them among the lands, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 30:26)**

**[Question]** What would the people of this system learn, when Yehowah takes up his mighty power?

**3• And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah will become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it will certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it peoples must stream. (Micah 4:1)**

**[Question]** Where will Yehowah's worship and government be established, in the final part of the days?

**4• And many nations will certainly go and say; Come, YOU people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah and to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will instruct us about his ways, and we will walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law will go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (Micah 4:2)**

**[Question]** What then will all peoples actively seek out from God?

**[Question]** What will then issue forth from Zion, his ruling authority?

**5• And he will certainly render judgment among many peoples, and set matters straight respecting mighty nations far away. And they will have to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. They will not lift up sword, nation against nation, neither will they learn war anymore. (Micah 4:3)**

**[Question]** What effect will Yehowah's judgments have upon the disparate nations of the earth?

**[Question]** What will they never learn, or practice again?

- 6· **And they will actually sit, each one under his vine and under his fig tree, and there will be no one making them tremble, for the very mouth of Yehowah of armies has spoken it. (Micah 4:4)**

**[Question]** How then will all the peoples of the earth dwell?

- 7· **For all the peoples, for their part, will walk each one in the name of its god, but we, for our part, shall walk in the name of Yehowah our God to time indefinite, even forever. (Micah 4:5)**

**[Question]** What name will the people knowing the true God, then walk in forever?

- 8· **That people may know that you, whose name is Yehowah, you alone are the Most High over all the earth. (Psalms 83:18)**

**[Question]** What is the unique name of the creator of heaven and earth?

- 9· **Yehowah has made his salvation known, in the eyes of the nations he has revealed his righteousness. (Psalms 98:2)**

**[Question]** What then will Yehowah reveal in the eyes of the nations?

- 10· **For the earth will be filled with the knowing of the glory of Yehowah as the waters themselves cover over the sea. (Habakkuk 2:14)**

**[Question]** What will all the earth, then become filled with?

- 11· **From the region of the rivers of Ethiopia the ones entreating me, namely, the daughter of my scattered ones, will bring a gift to me. (Zephaniah 3:10)**

**[Question]** From how far will the daughter of Zion, her dispersed ones, bring in a gift to his house?

- 12· **For from the sun's rising even to its setting my name will be great among the nations, and in every place sacrificial smoke will be made, a presentation will be made to my**

**name, even a clean gift, because my name will be great among the nations, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 1:11)**

**[Question]** How then will the illustrious name of Yehowah, be treated among all peoples of the earth?

**13· Whenever you vow a vow to God, do not hesitate to pay it, for there is no delight in the stupid ones. What you vow, pay. (Ecclesiastes 5:4)**
