

Isaiah 27:6~ In the coming days Jacob will take root, Israel will put forth blossoms and actually sprout, and they will simply fill the surface of the productive land with produce.

1· During the thousand years, Jacob or Israel, the seed of promise, will blossom and sprout. They will put down roots, becoming firm in their **stronghold, Yehowah their God. They will then prosper, and their spiritual fruitage will fill the surface of the productive land. They will not be continually oppressed by wicked men and governments led by Satan, but will prosper in the way of righteousness.**

[Question] What will sprout during the thousand years of peace, and what produce will come forth in abundance?

[Question] What restraining influence, will then be gone, allowing for rapid growth in righteousness?

2· Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Now is when I shall bring back the captive ones of Jacob and actually have mercy upon all the house of Israel, and I will show exclusive devotion for my holy name. (Ezekiel 39:25)

[Question] What does Yehowah promise to do for all the captive ones of Israel, because of his great name?

3· Those who are planted in the house of Yehowah, in the courtyards of our God, they will blossom forth. (Psalms 92:13)

[Question] What will then be the case, with those planted in Yehowah's house?

4· And those who escape of the house of Judah, those who are left remaining, will certainly take root downward and produce fruitage upward. (Isaiah 37:31)

[Question] What will then happen, to those escaped ones of the house of Judah?

5· The little one himself will become a thousand, and the small one a mighty nation. I myself, Yehowah, shall speed it up in its own time. (Isaiah 60:22)

[Question] What will a little one then become, and a small one become, and who will speed it up in its own time?

- 6· **And from them there will certainly go forth thanksgiving, and the sound of those who are laughing. And I will multiply them, and they will not become few, and I will make them heavy in number, and they will not become insignificant. (Jeremiah 30:19)**

[Question] What will then come forth from his people?

[Question] What promise does he then make to them?

- 7· **I shall become like the dew to Israel. He will blossom like the lily, and will strike his roots like Lebanon. (Hosea 14:5)**

[Question] What then will Yehowah God become to his people, and what will this cause to come forth?
