

Isaiah 2:21~ In order to enter into the holes in the rocks and into the clefts of the crags, because of the dreadfulness of Yehowah and from his splendid superiority, when he rises up for the earth to suffer shocks.

1· When Yehowah rises up to take dominion over the entire earth, men who have opposed him will have nowhere to hide. They will pray and sacrifice to all of their idol gods, but they will get no satisfaction. The earth will be rocked, as it realizes how very far off from **Yehowah's way, it is. Yehowah will act with full dominion and power, and rock the very foundations of the earth.**
