

Isaiah 30:26~ And the light of the full moon must become as the light of the glowing sun, and the very light of the glowing sun will become seven times as much, like the light of seven days, in the day that Yehowah binds up the breakdown of his people and heals even the severe wound resulting from the stroke by him.

1· Several symbols are used here. The Moon represents God's angelic organization and the Sun, symbolizes Yehowah God. [For a complete discussion see Revealing The Sons Of God – Chapter 7]

[Question] What symbols are here used, and what do they represent?

2· The light from both spiritual luminaries getting seven times brighter, denotes, that spiritual light or insight from Yehowah and his angelic organization will get, seven times, heavenly completeness, stronger, opened wide to heal the breakdown of his people. He will then shower them with spiritual enlightenment, so as to cause recuperation and spiritual healing to spring up among his people.

[Question] What does the light getting seven times brighter mean spiritually?

3· No more will your sun set, nor will your moon go on the wane, for Yehowah himself will become for you an indefinitely lasting light, and the days of your mourning will have come to completion. (Isaiah 60:20)

[Question] What then will no longer happen, and why?

4· As for his brightness, it got to be just like the light. He had two rays issuing out of his hand, and there the hiding of his strength was. (Habakkuk 3:4)

[Question] What vision of Yehowah God did Habakkuk see?

5· Sun, moon, stood still, in the lofty abode thereof. Like light your own arrows kept going. The lightning of your spear served for brightness. (Habakkuk 3:11)

[Question] Like the Sun and Moon who reside in a lofty abode, heaven?

[Question] What are their arrows likened to?

6· And the city has no need of the sun nor of the moon to

shine upon it, for the glory of God lighted it up, and its lamp was the Lamb. (**Revelation 21:23**)

[Question] Why does the holy city, New Jerusalem not need the literal Sun and Moon for light?

[Question] What symbolic lights light it up?

- 7· **Also, night will be no more, and they have no need of lamplight nor do they have sunlight, because Yehowah God will shed light upon them, and they will rule as kings forever and ever. (Revelation 22:5)**

[Question] What will those living in the New Jerusalem, have no need of?

- 8· **Of what shall I use you as a witness? What shall I liken to you, O daughter of Jerusalem? What shall I make equal to you, that I may comfort you, O virgin daughter of Zion? For your breakdown is just as great as the sea. Who can bring healing to you? (Lamentations 2:13)**

[Question] Who is the daughter of Zion?

[Question] Why is the extent of their breakdown?

- 9· **SEE now that I, I am He, and there are no gods together with me. I put to death, and I make alive. I have severely wounded, and I, I will heal, and there is no one snatching out of my hand. (Deuteronomy 32:39)**

[Question] Why is Yehowah God rightly called Almighty God?

- 10· **Here I am bringing up for her a recuperation and health, and I will heal them and reveal to them an abundance of peace and truth. (Jeremiah 33:6)**

[Question] What though, would Yehowah bring upon his people in abundance?

- 11· **Come, YOU people, and do let us return to Yehowah, for he himself has torn in pieces but he will heal us. He kept striking, but he will bind us up. (Hosea 6:1)**

[Question] Why did they eventually come back to their God?

- 12· **In that day I shall raise up the booth of David that is fallen, and I shall certainly repair their breaches. And its ruins I**

shall raise up, and I shall certainly build it up as in the days of long ago. (Amos 9:11)

[Question] What promises to their forefathers would Yehowah be loyal to?
