

Isaiah 30:8~ **Now come, write it upon a tablet with them, and inscribe it even in a book, that it may serve for a future day, for a witness to time indefinite.**

1· History often repeats itself, for the very reason, that men refuse to listen and learn from their failures. Therefore God's wisdom is inscribed into a book, the Bible, so that men of future generations may learn from this collected wisdom. We today, are the **future** generation, the generation that it has pointed to all along, the generation upon whom Yehowah will execute judgment.

3· And Yehowah proceeded to say to me; Take for yourself a large tablet and write upon it with the stylus of mortal man, Maher-shalal-hash-baz. (**Isaiah 8:1**)

[Question] What did Yehowah counsel Isaiah to do with his words?

4· Take for yourself a roll of a book, and you must write in it all the words that I have spoken to you against Israel and against Judah and against all the nations, since the day that I spoke to you, since the days of Josiah, clear down to this day. (**Jeremiah 36:2**)

[Question] What also was Jeremiah told to do, and why?

5· For all the things that were written aforetime were written for our instruction, that through our endurance and through the comfort from the Scriptures we might have hope. (**Romans 15:4**)

[Question] Why were all of these thing written down for us?
