

Isaiah 34:10~ **By night or by day it will not be extinguished, to time indefinite its smoke will keep ascending. From generation to generation she will be parched, forever and ever no one will be passing across her.**

1• Their **destruction** will be permanent, for once God's thousand year reign begins, there will be no more non-spiritual men. The continuing **smoke** of their estrangement from Yehowah will continue for generation after generation. She is **parched**, for she will never be watered again, for she brought forth only thorns and thistles. No one will ever pass across her again, for mankind will have learned a better way, **a way of spiritual living, a way of peace and love.**

[Question] What continuing evidence of their everlasting destruction will rise forever?

[Question] What will then be lacking in her from generation other generation?

[Question] What will mankind then have learned to replace her way?

2• Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Look! My anger and my rage are being poured forth upon this place, upon mankind and upon domestic animal, and upon the tree of the field and upon the fruitage of the ground, and it must burn, and it will not be extinguished. **(Jeremiah 7:20)**

[Question] Where then, will Yehowah's rage and anger be poured out, and to what extent?

3• And you must say to the forest of the south; Hear the word of Yehowah. This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am setting a fire ablaze against you, and it must devour in you every still-moist tree and every dry tree. The kindling flame will not be extinguished, and by it all faces must be scorched from the south to the north. **(Ezekiel 20:47)**

[Question] What will Yehowah set ablaze in the forest of the south, and who will it consume?

4• And right away for the second time they said; Praise Yah, **you** people! And the smoke from her goes on ascending forever and ever. **(Revelation 19:3)**

[Question] What smoke ascends forever from Babylon's destruction?

- 5· **She will never be inhabited, nor will she reside for generation after generation. And there the Arab will not pitch his tent, and no shepherds will let their flocks lie down there. (Isaiah 13:20)**

[Question] For generation after generation, what will no longer be found within her?

- 6· **There will not pass through it the foot of earthling man, nor will the foot of domestic animal pass through it, and for forty years it will not be inhabited. (Ezekiel 29:11)**

[Question] How long then would she not be inhabited?

- 7· **Because Edom keeps saying; We have been shattered, but we shall return and build the devastated places, this is what Yehowah of armies has said; They, for their part, will build, but I, for my part, shall tear down. And people will certainly call them **the territory of wickedness** and **the people whom Yehowah has denounced to time indefinite.** (Malachi 1:4)**
