

Isaiah 3:5~

**And the people will actually tyrannize one over the other, even each one over his fellowman. They will storm, the boy against the old man, and the lightly esteemed one against the one to be honored.**

**1· Since they have disrespected Yehowah's authority, he will let them tyrannize over one another, making no clear distinctions. Young boys will not respect the old men, and men who have done nothing with their lives, will challenge those who are deserving of honor. There will be no respect for authority, for they have disrespected, that which deserves true respect, his anointed one, and so their very authority will come to nothing.**

**[Question]** What will Yehowah then allow, because they have disrespected his authority?

**2· But know this, that in the last days critical times hard to deal with will be here. (2 Timothy 3:1)**

**[Question]** What kind of a time will the Last Days be?

**3· For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, self-assuming, haughty, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, disloyal. (2 Timothy 3:2)**

**[Question]** What kinds of attitudes, would people then display?

**[Question]** Do we today, see all these things in people?

**4· Having no natural affection, not open to any agreement, slanderers, without self-control, fierce, without love of goodness. (2 Timothy 3:3)**

**[Question]** How then would their attitudes differ, from the godly way of the past?

**5· Betrayers, headstrong, puffed up with pride, lovers of pleasures rather than lovers of God. (2 Timothy 3:4)**

**[Question]** What would they become lovers of, rather than of God?

**6· In the fury of Yehowah of armies the land has been set afire, and the people will become as food for the fire. No one will show compassion even on his brother. (Isaiah 9:19)**

**[Question]** What will Yehowah's anger bring, and what will all the wicked ones become then?

- 7· **And they keep trifling each one with his companion, and they speak no truth at all. They have taught their tongue to speak falsehood. They have tired themselves out merely in doing wrong. (Jeremiah 9:5)**

**[Question]** How do they treat the truth?

**[Question]** How do they tire themselves out?

- 8· **You the ones who have also eaten the organism of my people, and have stripped their very skin from off them, and smashed to pieces their very bones, and crushed them to pieces like what is in a widemouthed pot and like flesh in the midst of a cooking pot. (Micah 3:3)**

**[Question]** How did their religious leaders treat them, and what did they view them as?

- 9· **And now they have laughed at me, those younger in days than I am, whose fathers I would have refused to place with the dogs of my flock. (Job 30:1)**

**[Question]** How did Job address his change of status?

- 10· **Before gray hair you should rise up, and you must show consideration for the person of an old man, and you must be in fear of your God. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 19:32)**

**[Question]** What must be shown, toward the person of an old man?

- 11· **And King David came as far as Bahurim, and, look! Coming out from there was a man of the family of Saul's house, and his name was Shimei, the son of Gera, coming out and calling down evil as he came out. (2 Samuel 16:5)**

**[Question]** What did Shimei call out, against Israel's King David?

- 12· **Gray-headedness is a crown of beauty when it is found in the way of righteousness. (Proverbs 16:31)**

**[Question]** How is gray-headedness among, righteous ones, viewed by God?

- 13· **I have seen servants on horses but princes walking on the**

earth just like servants. (**Ecclesiastes 10:7**)

**[Question]** What disparity did the congregator witness?

**14·** And some started to spit on him and to cover his whole face and hit him with their fists and say to him; Prophecy! And, slapping him in the face, the court attendants took him. (**Mark 14:65**)

**[Question]** How did men treat the Messiah, Jesus Christ, to defame him?

**[Question]** Was Jesus Christ an older man considering his demonstrated wisdom and years with Yehowah God?
