

**Isaiah 44:8~ Do not be in dread, you people, and do not become stupefied. Have I not from that time on caused you individually to hear and told it out? And you are my witnesses. Does there exist a God besides me? No, there is no Rock. I have recognized none.**

**1• Yehowah's people need never dread, for there are no other gods. Neither do they need to act stupidly, or lack sound direction. From the beginning Yehowah has told just how the future would unfold and everyone who has read the Bible knows that his words always come true.**

**[Question]** What things do God's people not need to fear?

**[Question]** What direction will Yehowah God always provide for his people?

**2• Hey there, all you thirsty ones! Come to the water. And the ones that have no money! Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk even without money and without price. (Isaiah 55:1)**

**[Question]** What does Yehowah invite people, even ones without money, to buy from him?

**3• Why do you people keep paying out money for what is not bread, and why is your toil for what results in no satisfaction? Listen intently to me, and eat what is good, and let your soul find its exquisite delight in fatness itself. (Isaiah 55:2)**

**[Question]** What are people paying for, who go to false religious sources looking for truth?

**[Question]** Will they be satisfied with the results they get?

**[Question]** Whom must men listen to, to be spiritually fed and grow fat?

**4• Incline your ear and come to me. Listen, and your soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with you people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (Isaiah 55:3)**

**[Question]** Those coming to Yehowah, will gain what?

**5• Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups.**

**(Isaiah 55:4)**

**[Question]** Whom has Yehowah given to his people today, to lead them, and the national groups?

- 6· **Look! A nation that you do not know you will call, and those of a nation who have not known you will run even to you, for the sake of Yehowah your God, and for the Holy One of Israel, because he will have beautified you. (Isaiah 55:5)**

**[Question]** Who will run even to the Son of Man for spiritual instruction, and why?

- 7· **Therefore, you are his witnesses! For you have all seen prophecies in his word come true, many of them repeatedly. Has anyone else ever been able to do this, thousands of years in advance? Yehowah thus refers to himself as the **rock, unmovable, unshakeable, enduring, never changing.****

**[Question]** What have all Christians seen today, particularly regarding these last days?

**[Question]** Has any other God come forth with such accurate predictions thousands of years in advance?

**[Question]** What unchanging qualities, does Yehowah then show?

- 8· **Like a **rock**, we can depend on his promises all coming true. They can be depended upon as the foundation stone of our lives. What he says is going to happen, actually happens. He does not waver or vacillate. Thousands of years may go by from promise to fulfillment, but not one word of his good promise to the sons of mankind ever fails to come true.**

**[Question]** What must become the foundation stone of our lives?

**[Question]** What sometimes happens before we see fulfillment of his promises, yet what is always true in the long run?

- 9· **Now, look! I am going today in the way of all the earth, and **YOU** well know with all **YOUR** hearts and with all **YOUR** souls that not one word out of all the good words that Yehowah **YOUR** God has spoken to **YOU** has failed. They have all come true for **YOU**. Not one word of them has failed. (Joshua 23:14)**

**[Question]** What did faithful Joshua testify to at the end of his life of service to Yehowah God?

- 10· **You will not need to be afraid of any sudden dreadful thing, nor of the storm upon the wicked ones, because it is coming. (Proverbs 3:25)**

**[Question]** What promise does Yehowah make to faithful ones about surviving Har-Mageddon?

- 11· **For Yehowah himself will prove to be, in effect, your confidence, and he will certainly keep your foot against capture. (Proverbs 3:26)**

**[Question]** What will prove to be the confidence of such faithful ones?

- 12· **Do not be afraid, for I am with you. Do not gaze about, for I am your God. I will fortify you. I will really help you. I will really keep fast hold of you with my right hand of righteousness. (Isaiah 41:10)**

**[Question]** What can all faithful men be assured of daily?

- 13· **You are my witnesses, is the utterance of Yehowah, even my servant whom I have chosen, in order, that you may know and have faith in me, and that you may understand that I am the same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none. (Isaiah 43:10)**

**[Question]** What must all who serve God, become aware of, about him?

- 14· **I also kept telling you from that time. Before it could come in, I caused you to hear it, that you might not say, My own idol has done them, and my own carved image and my own molten image have commanded them. (Isaiah 48:5)**

**[Question]** Why did Yehowah prophesy so many things so many years ago, so as to make them come true in our day?

**[Question]** When Yehowah brings destruction of false religion and the nations in our day just ahead, what will men not be able to say about his word that many have said in the past about it?

- 15· **And he began to say to Abram; You may know for sure**

**that your seed will become an alien resident in a land not theirs, and they will have to serve them, and these will certainly afflict them for four hundred years. (Genesis 15:13)**

**[Question]** What prophecy did Yehowah make to Abraham, and how was it fulfilled?

- 16· And it must occur that if you will not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I am commanding you today, all these maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you. (Deuteronomy 28:15)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah promise to bring upon his people for failure to listen to, and perform his commands?

- 17· The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (Deuteronomy 32:4)**

**[Question]** What is Yehowah God like?

- 18· For who is a God besides Yehowah, and who is a rock besides our God? (2 Samuel 22:32)**

**[Question]** Are there any other gods besides Yehowah God, and why is he called a rock?
