

Isaiah 45:17~ As for Israel, he will certainly be saved in union with Yehowah with a salvation for times indefinite. You people will not be ashamed, nor will you be humiliated for the indefinite times of eternity.

1· All who look to Israel's God, who is real, true and able to save, will never again be humiliated. Israel will not need to be ashamed, for they have not believed in a lie. Their God will guide and protect them, even into the time of eternity.

[Question] What will Israel never experience, and why?

[Question] Why will they never be ashamed for what is their God in truth?

2· But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I will save them by Yehowah their God, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (Hosea 1:7)

[Question] Upon whom will God show his mercy, and by what means?

3· Trust in Yehowah, you people, for all times, for in Yah, Yehowah is the Rock of times indefinite. (Isaiah 26:4)

[Question] Why can people rightly trust in Yehowah God?

4· Therefore this is what Yehowah has said to the house of Jacob, he that redeemed Abraham; Jacob will not now be ashamed, nor will his own face now grow pale. (Isaiah 29:22)

[Question] What does Yehowah promise, that Jacob will not be?

5· Raise YOUR eyes to the heavens themselves, and look at the earth beneath. For the very heavens must be dispersed in fragments just like smoke, and like a garment the earth itself will wear out, and its inhabitants themselves will die like a mere gnat. But as for my salvation, it will prove to be even to time indefinite, and my own righteousness will not be shattered. (Isaiah 51:6)

[Question] What will eventually happen to the heavens and the earth?

[Question] How long though, will Yehowah's salvation last?

- 6· **Do not be afraid, for you will not be put to shame, and do not feel humiliated, for you will not be disappointed. For you will forget even the shame of your time of youth, and the reproach of your continuous widowhood you will remember no more. (Isaiah 54:4)**

[Question] What can all Israel rest assured of?

[Question] What things of past disciplinary actions by God, will they then remember no more?

- 7· **Also, none of those hoping in you will be ashamed. They will be ashamed who are dealing treacherously without success. (Psalms 25:3)**

[Question] What will those hoping in Yehowah not feel, but who will feel it?

- 8· **And YOU will certainly eat, eating and becoming satisfied, and YOU will be bound to praise the name of Yehowah YOUR God, who has done with YOU so wonderfully, and my people will not be ashamed to time indefinite. (Joel 2:26)**

[Question] How will Yehowah's people then fare, and how will they feel then?

- 9· **In that day you will not be ashamed because of all your dealings with which you transgressed against me, for then I shall remove from the midst of you your haughtily exultant ones, and you will never again be haughty in my holy mountain. (Zephaniah 3:11)**

[Question] What then will Yehowah remove from among them, and so how will they never act again?
