

Isaiah 47:14~ **Look! They have become like stubble. A fire itself will certainly burn them up. They will not deliver their soul from the power of the flame. There will be no glow of charcoals for people to warm themselves, no firelight in front of which to sit down.**

1• Jehovah's Witnesses and all of the rest of Christendom are like mere stubble, worthless in accomplishing Yehowah's further purposes. The only thing that he can do with them, is to burn them up in the fire of his anger. They have destroyed his spiritual sons whom they were sent to gather, rejected the Son of Man, his High Priest, and they have called divine truth apostasy.

2• They are not even as substantive as wood, which when burned leaves charcoals, to keep a fire going and to warm oneself. They are mere stubble, which burns up completely and it is gone. That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because Yehowah God, who judged her, is strong.

[Question] What then, is to come upon Babylon, and why?

3• That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because Yehowah God, who judged her, is strong. (Revelation 18:8)

[Question] What then, will come upon her, and with what result?

4• And in the abundance of your superiority you can throw down those who rise up against you. You send out your burning anger, it eats them up like stubble. (Exodus 15:7)

[Question] What way does Yehowah treat all those, who rise up against him, and what do they become like to him?

5• Never yet have they been planted, never yet have they been sown, never yet has their stump taken root in the earth. And one has only to blow upon them and they dry

up, and like stubble the windstorm itself will carry them away. (Isaiah 40:24)

[Question] What are the nations of the earth like to Yehowah God in all the earth?

[Question] What only will he have to do to remove them?

- 6· For Yehowah your God is a consuming fire, a God exacting exclusive devotion. (Deuteronomy 4:24)**
