

Isaiah 50:6~ My back I gave to the strikers, and my cheeks to those plucking off the hair. My face I did not conceal from humiliating things and spit.

1· Just as soon as I was anointed as King on June 13,2001, I came under attack by Satan the Devil and his demons. I was falsely arrested on an insignificant charge. I then lost an excellent paying job, got divorced, my grown children all moved away, I was involved in a life-threatening car accident, I sold my house but could not find work, I was falsely accused by my new daughter-in-Law of physically threatening her, I was Baker Acted by my wife the day after the car accident, and released 72 hours later without treatment.

[Question] What attack by Satan the Devil did the Son of Man come under in June of 2003 C.E?

2· I was accused of being a child-molester by my daughter-in-Law, I was disfellowshipped by Jehovah's Witnesses for apostasy, for writing a book about the Bible, my brother and father died, I became homeless and have had to live in a tent for five years. Through all of this, I have let people who wanted to falsely accuse me, do so, and I have taken all of the abuse, that those who hate me can dish out.

[Question] What false accusations were made then against the Son of Man, and what stressful circumstances did he have to endure?

[Question] What response has the Son of Man made to all of this humiliation from others?

3· My local Body of Elders also slandered me, by saying that I had never been out in the preaching work, though they knew better, for there are (15) Bible students, and several of them today are Elders, whom I have studied with in the past to the point of baptism.

[Question] What did even the local body of elders say, and do to me?

4· I lost three new cars and my credit was destroyed. I was arrested a second time, because I never received the notice of the first court appearance. I was then rear-ended in a second accident and arrested again, because of the open warrant. I then spent a week in jail, and was nearly killed there.

[Question] What further hard to deal with events, happened to me?

5· In the five years in my tent, I have been through two tornadoes and five serious hurricanes. During all of this time I have delighted to write thirteen additional spiritual books about much of the prophetic portions of the Bible, over one hundred and fourteen thousand pages of spiritual instruction. Yehowah has been with me in spirit and comforted me through all of my trials and tribulations. I love you Yehowah, my dear father.

[Question] What stresses has the Son of Man endured, while living in a small tent for four years since?

[Question] What fine spiritual work has the Son of Man taken up, and with what results?

[Question] Who has remained with me through all of this, and how does the Son of Man feel about Yehowah, his loving God and father?

6· Let him give his cheek to the very one striking him. Let him have his sufficiency of reproach. (Lamentations 3:30)

[Question] What though has the Son of Man said in defense, thereby accepting what?

7· At this time you make cuttings upon yourself, O daughter of an invasion, a siege he has laid against us. With the rod they will strike upon the cheek the judge of Israel. (Micah 5:1)

[Question] What has thus happened, to the judge of Israel?

8· Now the men that had him in custody began to make fun of him, hitting him. (Luke 22:63)

[Question] What did those who held Jesus in custody, do toward him?

9· And after covering him over they would ask and say; Prophecy. Who is it that struck you? (Luke 22:64)

[Question] What did the members of the Sanhedrin do to Jesus, ridiculing him?

10· And they went on saying many other things in blasphemy against him. (Luke 22:65)

[Question] What did they say against him, and what did it all amount to?

- 11· **After he said these things, one of the officers that was standing by gave Jesus a slap in the face and said; Is that the way you answer the chief priest? (John 18:22)**

[Question] How did they criticize his answers?

- 12· **Jesus answered him; If I spoke wrongly, bear witness concerning the wrong, but if rightly, why do you hit me? (John 18:23)**

[Question] How did Jesus Christ, then mildly answer his opposers?

- 13· **Then they spit into his face and hit him with their fists. Others slapped him in the face. (Matthew 26:67)**

[Question] What other things did Jesus' enemies do to him, with what response?

- 14· **Saying; Prophecy to us, you Christ. Who is it that struck you? (Matthew 26:68)**

[Question] How did the even mock him as God's prophet?

- 15· **And some started to spit on him and to cover his whole face and hit him with their fists and say to him; Prophecy! And, slapping him in the face, the court attendants took him. (Mark 14:65)**

[Question] What did some even do toward him?
