

Isaiah 52:10~ Yehowah has bared his holy arm before the eyes of all the nations, and all the ends of the earth must see the salvation of our God.

1· The second sign of Moses, of Moses putting his **arm** inside the fold of his garment, it becoming leprous, then returning it and it becoming sound again, means that Yehowah will use his own mighty **arm** to remove this sick and leprous system of things and replace it with one of his own making, sound and healthful in all respects.

[Question] What does the second sign of Moses mean spiritually?

2· Then Yehowah said to him once more; Stick your hand, please, into the upper fold of your garment. So he stuck his hand into the upper fold of his garment. When he drew it out, why, here his hand was stricken with leprosy like snow! (**Exodus 4:6**)

[Question] What was Moses told to do with his own arm, and with what result?

3· After that he said; Return your hand into the upper fold of your garment. So he returned his hand into the upper fold of his garment. When he drew it out of the upper fold of his garment, why, here it was restored like the rest of his flesh! (**Exodus 4:7**)

[Question] What then was he told to do, and with what result?

4· And it must occur that, to quote him, if they will not believe you and will not listen to the voice of the first sign, then they will certainly believe the voice of the later sign. (**Exodus 4:8**)

[Question] What additional confidence would this give to God's people?

5· Thus, by revealing this understanding to men, he is **baring his holy arm**, in preparation of the work of bringing the Kingdom to birth. Thus, that actual bringing forth of his anointed congregation will be the **baring of his arm** to all of the nations. Then all of mankind will see the saving power, the salvation of our God, by means of his 144,000 resurrected ones. No more will

false religionists claim to be his anointed sons, for he himself will have spoken.

[Question] How then is Yehowah baring his holy arm, and in preparation for what?

[Question] What then, will all mankind see, but especially his anointed congregation of the 144,000?

[Question] What false hope, will then be completely dashed to pieces, on the basis of truth?

6· And he proceeded to say; It has been more than a trivial matter for you to become my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back even the safeguarded ones of Israel, I also have given you for a light of the nations, that my salvation may come to be to the extremity of the earth. (Isaiah 49:6)

[Question] Has then, the bringing forth of the Son of Man today been a trivial matter, as some men have accounted it?

[Question] Why has the Son of Man come forth today, and what will result from his efforts?

7· Awake, awake, clothe yourself with strength, O arm of Yehowah! Awake as in the days of long ago, as during the generations of times long past. Are you not the one that broke Rahab to pieces, that pierced the sea monster? (Isaiah 51:9)

[Question] What does Isaiah call for Yehowah's arm to do, as it many times did, in the distant past?

8· You yourself have crushed Rahab, even as someone slain. By the arm of your strength you have scattered your enemies. (Psalms 89:10)

[Question] How did the Psalmist refer to the arm of Yehowah's strength?

9· And all flesh will see the saving means of God. (Luke 3:6)

[Question] What then, will all flesh be able to actually see?
