

Isaiah 53:11~ Because of the trouble of his soul he will see, he will be satisfied. By means of his knowledge the righteous one, my servant, will bring a righteous standing to many people, and their errors he himself will bear.

1• The Son of Man has seen **wisdom**, due to the trouble of his own soul. Like my heavenly father, who has alone endured the errors of all mankind for six thousand years, I have in a comparatively small way, learned the value of always being forgiving, and waiting in love to give mercy a chance. Come what may, I will be satisfied in this course.

[Question] What vision has the Son of Man obtained through his many troubles?

[Question] What merciful and loving way, has the Son of Man learned like his father before him, through the many troubles he has experienced?

[Question] What will become the Son of Man source of satisfaction?

2• By **means of my knowledge**, **the fifteen books that I have thus produced by God's spirit**, many will obtain a righteous standing and come to serve God in truth. Thus for one to become a **pillar** in the congregation, all must be willing to bear the transgressions and errors of one another. To do so is in imitation of him, and a glory to him.

[Question] What will yet be obtained, by many who read the fifteen books thus far produced by the Son of Man, through God's spirit?

3• And I saw another strong angel descending from heaven, arrayed with a cloud, and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as the sun, and his feet were as fiery pillars. (**Revelation 10:1**)

[Question] What angel was seen descending from heaven, and how was he arrayed, and how did he appear?

[Question] Who is this angel today, and is he on earth? **[See Also Revelation - An Unveiling, under this verse]**

4• The one that conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God, and he will by no means go out from it anymore, and I will write upon him the name of my God and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem which descends out of heaven from my God, and that new

name of mine. (**Revelation 3:12**)

[Question] What will the one who conquers, become in the spiritual temple of God?

[Question] What names will then be written upon him, as a pillar of the congregation of God?

- 5· **Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? Father, save me out of this hour. Nevertheless, this is why I have come to this hour. (John 12:27)**

[Question] Through what troubled hour, did Jesus Christ ask his father to save him out of?

- 6· **In order that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He that does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent him. (John 5:23)**

[Question] Does anyone not honoring the son, honor the father?

- 7· **Therefore because he was exalted to the right hand of God and received the promised Holy Spirit from the Father, he has poured out this which you see and hear. (Acts of Apostles 2:33)**

[Question] What was Jesus able to pour out upon his disciples, and what did this prove?

- 8· **God exalted this one as Chief Agent and Savior to his right hand, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins. (Acts of Apostles 5:31)**

[Question] What has Yehowah God constituted his son as?

- 9· **For this very reason also God exalted him to a superior position and kindly gave him the name that is above every other name. (Philippians 2:9)**

[Question] Why did God exalt his son, and give his a name above every other?

- 10· **So that in the name of Jesus every knee should bend of those in heaven and those on earth and those under the ground. (Philippians 2:10)**

[Question] Who then, should bend the knee to the Son of Man?

- 11· **And every tongue should openly acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:11)**

[Question] What should every tongue acknowledge, about the Son of Man?

- 12· **Look! My servant, on whom I keep fast hold! My chosen one, whom my soul has approved! I have put my spirit in him. Justice to the nations is what he will bring forth. (Isaiah 42:1)**

[Question] Who has Yehowah placed his spirit upon, and for what purpose?

- 13· **So, then, as through one trespass the result to men of all sorts was condemnation, likewise also through one act of justification the result to men of all sorts is a declaring of them righteous for life. (Romans 5:18)**

[Question] What resulted from one trespass to all men?

[Question] What will result from one act of justification?

- 14· **For just as through the disobedience of the one man many were constituted sinners, likewise also through the obedience of the one person many will be constituted righteous. (Romans 5:19)**

[Question] Who were constituted as sinners as a result of Adam's sin?

[Question] Who were constituted sinners because of Adam's sin?

[Question] Who likewise will be constituted righteous and through whose obedience?

- 15· **He himself bore our sins in his own body upon the stake, in order, that we might be done with sins and live to righteousness. And by his stripes YOU were healed. (1 Peter 2:24)**

[Question] Whose sins did the Christ have to bear?

[Question] For what purpose did the Christ bear the sins of others?
