

Isaiah 55:9~ For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so my ways are higher than YOUR ways, and my thoughts than YOUR thoughts.

1· In the Bible the term, **heaven, at times refers to the atmosphere above our heads.**

[Question] What does the Bible use the term heaven to mean?

2· And God began to call the expanse Heaven. And there came to be evening and there came to be morning, a second day. (Genesis 1:8**)**

[Question] What was the expanse above the waters of the oceans and the earth called?

3· This atmosphere is always higher than the **earth or the **sea**, even higher than tall **mountains**. In the same way God's thoughts are **higher, better, more righteous than man's**. Yehowah however, does not exclude mankind from his thinking and actions, but he lovingly invites us to share in his thinking and ways. He does this through the Bible, and by means of his spirit.**

[Question] What is this expanse of heaven always higher than?

[Question] What comparison is then made, between God's thoughts and ours?

[Question] Since God's thoughts are superior to ours, what does he lovingly invite us to share in with him?

[Question] How is this invitation extended, and how is it realized?

4· Through the sea your way was, and your path was through many waters, and your very footprints have not come to be known. (Psalms 77:19**)**

[Question] What pathway, have men not yet come to see clearly?

5· For as the heavens are higher than the earth, this loving-kindness is superior toward those fearing him. (Psalms 103:11**)**

[Question] What also is compared, to the highness of the heavens above the earth?

6· O the depth of God's riches and wisdom and knowledge! How unsearchable his judgments are and past tracing out his ways are! (Romans 11:33**)**

[Question] What did Paul say about the depth of God's wisdom and knowledge and his judgments?

- 7· **At that time Jesus said in response; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and intellectual ones and have revealed them to babes. (Matthew 11:25)**

[Question] Which ones has Yehowah chosen to reveal his divine wisdom to, and why them?

- 8· **It was revealed to them that, not to themselves, but to you, they were ministering the things that have now been announced to you through those who have declared the Good News to you with Holy Spirit sent forth from heaven. Into these very things angels are desiring to peer. (1 Peter 1:12)**

[Question] Who were the ancient prophets ministering to?

[Question] Who is also desirous of knowing, what all of the divine prophecies mean?
