- **And all the utensils, great and small, of the house of the true God and the treasures of the house of Yehowah and the treasures of the king and of his princes, everything he brought to Babylon. (2 Chronicles 36:18)**
- **Look! Days are coming, and all that is in your own house and that your forefathers have stored up down to this day will actually be carried to Babylon. Nothing will be left, Yehowah has said. (Isaiah 39:6)**
- **Your resources and your treasures I shall give for mere plunder, not for a price, but for all your sins, even in all your territories. (Jeremiah 15:13)**
- **Then Pashhur struck Jeremiah the prophet and put him into the stocks that were in the Upper Gate of Benjamin, which was in the house of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 20:2)**
- **And the copper pillars that belonged to the house of Yehowah and the carriages and the copper sea that was in the house of Yehowah the Chaldeans broke to pieces and went carrying all the copper of them to Babylon. (Jeremiah 52:17)**
- **And the basins and the fire holders and the bowls and the cans and the lampstands and the cups and the bowls that were of genuine gold, and those that were of genuine silver, the chief of the bodyguard took. (Jeremiah 52:19)**
- **In time Yehowah gave into his hand Jehoiakim the king of Judah and a part of the utensils of the house of the true God, so that he brought them to the land of Shinar to the house of his god, and the utensils he brought to the treasure-house of his god. (Daniel 1:2)**

- So he brought up **against** them the king of the Chaldeans, who proceeded to kill their young men with the sword in the house of their **sanctuary**, neither did he feel compassion for young man or virgin, old or decrepit. Everything He gave into his **hand**. (**2 Chronicles 36:17**)
- They **have** thrust your **sanctuary** into the fire itself. They **have** profaned the tabernacle of your name to the very earth. (**Psalms 74:7**)
- O God, the **nations have come** into your inheritance, they **have** defiled your holy temple, they **have** laid Jerusalem in a heap of ruins. (**Psalms 79:1**)
- For a little while your holy people had possession. Our **own** adversaries **have** stamped down your **sanctuary**. (**Isaiah 63:18**)
- Our house of holiness and beauty, in which our forefathers praised you, **has** itself become something for burning in the fire, and every one of our **desirable things has** become a devastation. (**Isaiah 64:11**)
- And he proceeded to burn the house of Yehowah and the house of the king and all the houses of Jerusalem, and every great house he burned with fire. (**Jeremiah 52:13**)
- And I shall **have** to turn away my face from them, and they will actually profane my concealed place, and into it robbers will really **come** and profane it. (**Ezekiel 7:22**)
- And I shall indeed give **YOUR** cities to the sword and lay **YOUR** sanctuaries desolate, and I shall not smell **YOUR** restful odors. (**Leviticus 26:31**)
- And he proceeded to burn the house of Yehowah and the king's house and all the houses of Jerusalem, and the house of every great man he burned with fire. (**2 Kings 25:9**)
- And I will give all the stored-up **things** of this city and all its product and all its precious **things**, and all the treasures of the kings of Judah I am going to give into the **hand** of their enemies. And they will certainly plunder them and take them and bring them to Babylon. (**Jeremiah 20:5**)
- We **have** been put to shame, for we **have** heard reproach. Humiliation **has** covered our faces, for strangers **have come**

against the holy places of the house of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 51:51**)

- **Jerusalem has** remembered in the days of her affliction and of her homeless people all her **desirable things** that happened to be from days of long ago. When her people fell into the **hand** of the adversary and she had no helper; The adversaries saw her. They laughed over her collapse. (**Lamentations 1:7**)
- **Say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has** said; Here I am profaning my **sanctuary**, the pride of **YOUR** strength, the thing **desirable** to **YOUR** eyes and the object of **YOUR** soul's compassion, and **YOUR** sons and **YOUR** daughters whom **YOU** people **have** left behind, by the sword they will fall. (**Ezekiel 24:21**)
