

Lamentations 1:8

Jerusalem has committed outright sin. That is why she has become a mere abhorrent thing. All who were honoring her have treated her as something cheap, for they have seen her nakedness. She herself is also sighing and turns her back.

[20] - References:

- In case they sin against you, for there is no man that does not sin, and you **have** to be incensed at them and abandon them to the enemy, and their captors actually carry them off captive to the land of the enemy distant or nearby. (**1 Kings 8:46**)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They **have** left Yehowah, they **have treated** the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they **have** turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)
- No, but the very errors of **YOU** people **have become** the things causing division between **YOU** and **YOUR** God, and **YOUR** own sins **have** caused the concealing of his face from **YOU** to keep from hearing. (**Isaiah 59:2**)
- **All** of them are the most stubborn men, walking about as slanderers, copper and iron. They are all of them ruinous. (**Jeremiah 6:28**)
- Son of man, as regards a land, in case it commits sin against me in acting unfaithfully, I will also stretch out my hand against it and break for it the rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended, and I will send upon it famine and cut off from it earthling man and domestic animal. (**Ezekiel 14:13**)
- By your blood that you **have** shed you **have become** guilty, and by your dungy idols that you **have** made you **have become** unclean. And you bring your days near, and you will come to your years. That is **why** I must make you an object of reproach to the nations and of jeering to all the lands. (**Ezekiel 22:4**)
- I will also cut Israel off from upon the surface of the ground that I **have** given to them, and the house that I **have** sanctified to my name I shall throw away from before me, and Israel will indeed **become** a proverbial saying and a taunt among all the peoples. (**1 Kings 9:7**)

- The punishment for the error of the daughter of my people also **becomes** greater than the punishment for the sin of Sodom, which was overthrown as in a moment, and to which no hands turned helpfully. (**Lamentations 4:6**)
- I will also give them over for quaking, for calamity, in all the kingdoms of the earth, for reproach and for a proverbial saying, for a taunt and for a malediction, in all the places to which I shall disperse them. (**Jeremiah 24:9**)
- And when you will say in your heart, Why is it that these things **have** befallen me? Because of the abundance of your error your skirts **have** been taken off as a cover, your heels **have** been **treated** violently. (**Jeremiah 13:22**)
- And I myself also will lift up your skirts over your face, and your dishonor will certainly be **seen**. (**Jeremiah 13:26**)
- Therefore here I am collecting together all those passionately loving you toward whom you were pleasurable and all those whom you loved along with all those whom you hated, and I will collect them together against you from all around and uncover your private parts to them, and they must see all your private parts. (**Ezekiel 16:37**)
- And they must take action against you in hatred and take away all your product of toil and leave you naked and nude, and the nudeness of your acts of fornication and your loose conduct and your acts of prostitution must be uncovered. (**Ezekiel 23:29**)
- And now I shall uncover her private parts to the eyes of her passionate lovers, and there will be no man to snatch her out of my hand. (**Hosea 2:10**)
- For a voice like that of a sick woman I **have** heard, the distress like that of a woman giving birth to her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion who keeps gasping for breath. She keeps spreading out her palms; Woe, now, to me, for my soul is tired of the killers! (**Jeremiah 4:31**)
- For this city, from the day that they built it, clear down to this day, **has** proved to be nothing but a cause of anger in me and a cause of rage in me, in order to remove it from before my face. (**Jeremiah 32:31**)

- **Because of the fact that **you** made sacrificial smoke and that **you** sinned against Yehowah and did not obey the voice of Yehowah and in his Law and in his statutes and in his reminders **you** did not walk, that is **why** there **has** befallen **you** this calamity as at this day. (Jeremiah 44:23)**
- **Zion **has** spread out her hands. No comforter does she **have**. Yehowah **has** given a command concerning Jacob to all who are around him as his adversaries. Jerusalem **has become** an **abhorrent** thing in among them. (Lamentations 1:17)**
- **Into the streets they will throw their very silver, and an **abhorrent** thing their own gold will **become**. Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury. Their souls they will not satisfy, and their intestines they will not fill, for it **has become** a stumbling block causing their error. (Ezekiel 7:19)**
- **In that day there will come to be a well opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for an **abhorrent** thing. (Zechariah 13:1)**
