

Lamentations 2:13

Of what shall I use you as a witness? What shall I liken to you, O daughter of Jerusalem? What shall I make equal to you, that I may comfort you, O virgin daughter of Zion? For your breakdown is just as great as the sea. Who can bring healing to you?

[12] - References:

- **Is it nothing to all you who are passing along the way? Look and see. Does there exist any pain like my pain that has been severely dealt out to me, with which Yehowah has caused grief in the day of his burning anger? (Lamentations 1:12)**
- **Those two things were befalling you. Who will sympathize with you? Despoiling and breakdown, and hunger and sword! Who will comfort you? (Isaiah 51:19)**
- **Over the breakdown of the daughter of my people I have become shattered. I have grown sad. Outright astonishment has seized hold of me. (Jeremiah 8:21)**
- **And you must say to them this word, Let my eyes run down with tears night and day and let them not keep still, for with a great crash the virgin daughter of my people has been broken, with an extremely sickish stroke. (Jeremiah 14:17)**
- **And he proceeded to carry out his words that he had spoken against us and against our judges who judged us, by bringing upon us great calamity, such as was not done under the whole heavens as what has been done in Jerusalem. (Daniel 9:12)**
- **For this is what Yehowah has said; There is no cure for your breakdown. Your stroke is chronic. (Jeremiah 30:12)**
- **This is the word that Yehowah has spoken against him; The virgin daughter of Zion has despised you, she has held you in derision. Behind you the daughter of Jerusalem has wagged her head. (2 Kings 19:21)**
- **And the light of the full moon must become as the light of the glowing sun, and the very light of the glowing sun will become seven times as much, like the light of seven days, in the day that Yehowah binds up the breakdown of his people and heals even the severe wound resulting from the stroke by him. (Isaiah 30:26)**

- **Have you absolutely rejected Judah, or has your soul abhorred even Zion? Why is it that you have struck us, so that there is no healing for us? There was a hoping for peace, but no good came, and for a time of healing, and, look! Terror! (Jeremiah 14:19)**
- **Her uncleanness is in her skirts. She did not remember the future for her, and down she goes in a wondrous manner. No comforter does she have. O Yehowah, see my affliction, for the enemy has put on great airs. (Lamentations 1:9)**
- **Dread and the hollow themselves have become ours, desolateness and breakdown. (Lamentations 3:47)**
- **And for you in their lamentation they will certainly lift up a dirge and chant over you; Who is like Tyre, like her that has been brought to silence in the midst of the sea? (Ezekiel 27:32)**
