[19] - References:

- **And now say, please, to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem; This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am forming against YOU a calamity and thinking against YOU a thought. Turn back, please, each one from his bad way, and make YOUR ways and YOUR dealings good. (Jeremiah 18:11)**
- **Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am thinking up against this family a calamity from which YOU people will not remove YOUR necks, so that YOU will not walk haughtily, because it is a time of calamity. (Micah 2:3)**
- **But Yehowah said; Judah, too, I shall remove from my sight, just as I have removed Israel, and I shall certainly reject this city that I have chosen, even Jerusalem, and the house of which I have said, My name will continue there. (2 Kings 23:27)**
- **The One telling from the beginning the finale, and from long ago the things that have not been done, the One saying, My own counsel will stand, and everything that is my delight I shall do. (Isaiah 46:10)**
- **So my word that goes forth from my mouth will prove to be. It will not return to me without results, but it will certainly do that in which I have delighted, and it will have certain success in that for which I have sent it. (Isaiah 55:11)**
- **And I shall indeed set my face against YOU, and YOU will certainly be defeated before YOUR enemies, and those who hate YOU will just tread down upon YOU, and YOU will actually flee when no one is pursuing YOU. (Leviticus 26:17)**
- **And it must occur that if you will not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I am commanding you today, all these**

maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you.
(**Deuteronomy 28:15**)

- Therefore as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah; Surely for the reason that it was my sanctuary that you defiled with all your disgusting things and with all your detestable things, I myself also am the One that will diminish you and my eye will not feel sorry and I myself also will not show **compassion**. (**Ezekiel 5:11**)
- Neither will my eye feel sorry nor shall I feel **compassion**. According to your ways shall I do the bringing upon you yourself, and your own detestable things will come to be right in the midst of you, and **you** people will have to know that I am Yehowah doing the smiting. (**Ezekiel 7:9**)
- And as for me also, my eye will not feel sorry, neither shall I show **compassion**. Their way I shall certainly bring upon their own head. (**Ezekiel 9:10**)
- For I said; Otherwise they would **rejoice** at me, when my foot moved unsteadily, they would certainly assume great airs against me. (**Psalms 38:16**)
- You have exalted the right hand of his **adversaries**, you have caused all his enemies to **rejoice**. (**Psalms 89:42**)
- Her **adversaries** have become the head. Those who are her enemies are unconcerned. Because Yehowah himself **has** brought grief to her on account of the abundance of her transgressions. Her own children have walked captive before the adversary. (**Lamentations 1:5**)
- And the ark of God itself was captured, and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, died. (**1 Samuel 4:11**)
- So the news bearer answered and said; Israel **has** fled before the Philistines, and there **has** also occurred a great defeat among the people, and also your own two sons have died, Hophni and Phinehas, and the very ark of the true God **has** been captured. (**1 Samuel 4:17**)
- Yehowah **has** swallowed up, he **has shown** no **compassion** upon any abiding places of Jacob. In his fury he **has torn down** the fortified places of the daughter of Judah. He **has** brought into

- contact with the earth, he **has** profaned the kingdom and her princes. (**Lamentations 2:2**)
- For I myself, Yehowah, shall speak **what** word I shall speak, and it will be done. There will be no postponement anymore, for in **YOUR days**, O rebellious house, I shall speak a word and certainly do it, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 12:25**)
 - And all those of flesh must see that I myself, Yehowah, have set it afire, so that it will not be extinguished. (**Ezekiel 20:48**)
 - And he proceeded to carry out his words that he had spoken against us and against our judges who judged us, by bringing upon us great calamity, such as was not done under the whole heavens as **what has** been done in Jerusalem. (**Daniel 9:12**)
