

Lamentations 2:21

Boy and old man have lain down on the earth of the streets. My virgins and my young men themselves have fallen by the sword. You have killed in the day of your anger. You have slaughtered, you have had no compassion.

[21] - References:

- **A nation fierce in countenance, who will not be partial to an **old man** or show favor to a **young man**. (**Deuteronomy 28:50**)**
- **So he brought up against them the king of the Chaldeans, who proceeded to kill their **young men** with the **sword** in the house of their sanctuary, neither did he feel **compassion** for **young man** or virgin, **old** or decrepit. Everything He gave into his hand. (**2 Chronicles 36:17**)**
- **And I shall pound them fine like dust before the wind, like the mire of the **streets** I shall pour them out. (**Psalms 18:42**)**
- **For death has come up through our windows, it has come into our dwelling towers, in order to cut off the child from the street, the **young men** from the public squares. (**Jeremiah 9:21**)**
- **Therefore give their sons over to the famine, and deliver them over to the power of the **sword**, and may their wives become women bereaved of children, and widows. And may their own **men** become those **killed** with deadly plague, their **young men** those struck **down** with the **sword** in the battle. (**Jeremiah 18:21**)**
- **All my powerful ones Yehowah has tossed aside from the midst of me. He has called against me a meeting, in order to break my **young men** to pieces. Yehowah has trodden the very winepress belonging to the virgin daughter of Judah. (**Lamentations 1:15**)**
- **And after that, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall give Zedekiah the king of Judah and his servants and the people and those who are remaining over in this city from the pestilence, from the **sword** and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, even into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those who are seeking for their soul, and he will certainly strike them with the edge of the **sword**. He will not feel sorry for them, nor will he show **compassion** or **have** any mercy. (**Jeremiah 21:7**)**

- Old **man, young man** and virgin and little child and women **you** should kill off, to a ruination. But to any **man** upon whom there is the mark do not go near, and from my sanctuary **you** should start. So they started with the **old men** that were before the house. (**Ezekiel 9:6**)
- Preserving loving-kindness for thousands, pardoning error and transgression and sin, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons and upon grandsons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (**Exodus 34:7**)
- And I will dash them one against another, both the fathers and the sons, at the same time, is the utterance of Yehowah. I shall show no **compassion**, nor feel any sorrow, and I shall not **have** the mercy to keep from bringing them to ruin. (**Jeremiah 13:14**)
- Yehowah has swallowed up, he has shown no **compassion** upon any abiding places of Jacob. In his fury he has torn **down** the fortified places of the daughter of Judah. He has brought into contact with the **earth**, he has profaned the kingdom and her princes. (**Lamentations 2:2**)
- You **have** blocked approach with **anger**, and you keep pursuing us. You **have killed**, you **have** shown no **compassion**. (**Lamentations 3:43**)
- Therefore as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, surely for the reason that it was my sanctuary that you defiled with all your disgusting things and with all your detestable things, I myself also am the One that will diminish you and my eye will not feel sorry and I myself also will not show **compassion**. (**Ezekiel 5:11**)
- And my eye will not feel sorry for you, neither will I feel **compassion**, for upon you I shall bring your own ways, and in the midst of you your own detestable things will come to be, and **you** people will **have** to know that I am Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 7:4**)
- Outdoors a **sword** will bereave them, and indoors fright, of both **young man** and virgin, suckling together with gray-haired **man**. (**Deuteronomy 32:25**)
- By the **sword** your own **men** will fall, and your mightiness by war. (**Isaiah 3:25**)

- **Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am setting for this people stumbling blocks, and they will certainly stumble over them, fathers and sons together, the neighbor and his companion, they will perish. (Jeremiah 6:21)**
- **Therefore this is what Yehowah of armies has said; Here I am turning my attention upon them. The **young men** themselves will die by the **sword**. Their sons and their daughters themselves will die by the famine. (Jeremiah 11:22)**
- **Therefore her **young men** will fall in her public squares, and all the **men** of war themselves will be brought to silence in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (Jeremiah 49:26)**
- **My own eye has dealt severely with my soul, because of all the daughters of my city. (Lamentations 3:51)**
- **And he said further to them; Defile the house and fill the courtyards with the slain ones. Go forth! And they went forth and struck in the city. (Ezekiel 9:7)**
